#### Appendix 3 Different Indicators used when Measuring Student Enrollment

#### October 1<sup>st</sup> – Full Student Count

In order to track enrollment trends district's measure all students enrolled in all schools, grade PK thru 12+ on October 1<sup>st</sup>; or the closest date if October 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a weekend. This is a measure of total students attending our schools on approximately the same day every year. The enrollment for this count includes tuition students, foreign exchange students, middle school exchange students and High School choice students.

#### **Fall Public School Student Census**

The Fall Student Census is a collection by the AOE of instances of student enrollment in each school. In this collection the AOE ask for information for each student which is used to calculate a number of education indicators. For instance, the Fall Census is used to create the October 1 headcount of enrolled students, and the Average Daily Membership (ADM) as well as other calculations.

#### Students included in the Census include:

- Students who arrive in the morning and are transported to and from the technical center at the
  expense of the district
- Students attending an alternative program
- Students attending a pre-qualified Pre-kindergarten program
- Students enrolled in school and receiving tutoring by school staff at home or in hospital
- Students who are enrolled and in an approved educational experience outside school (i.e. page for legislature)
- Home study students who participate in academic classes or extra- curricular activities
- Student who have chosen to attend Harwood Union rather than their resident school through School Choice (formally Act 150)

#### Students who are not on the Census:

- Students attending an independent schools
- Students who have chosen to attend a different school through School Choice (formally Act 150)

#### Average Daily Membership (ADM)

ADM is a count of <u>resident</u> and state-placed students who receive an elementary or secondary education at public expense. Resident students are counted during the period from the 11<sup>th</sup> to the 30<sup>th</sup> day of the current school year, while state-placed students are counted for the school year prior to the current census period. ADM Data are used in calculating equalized pupils which are used to determine the homestead tax rates.

#### Equalized Pupils – Title 16, VSA, Section 4001


"Equalized pupils" means the long-term weighted average daily membership multiplied by the ratio of the statewide long-term average daily membership to the statewide long term weighted average daily membership. In other words, a two year weighted average.
