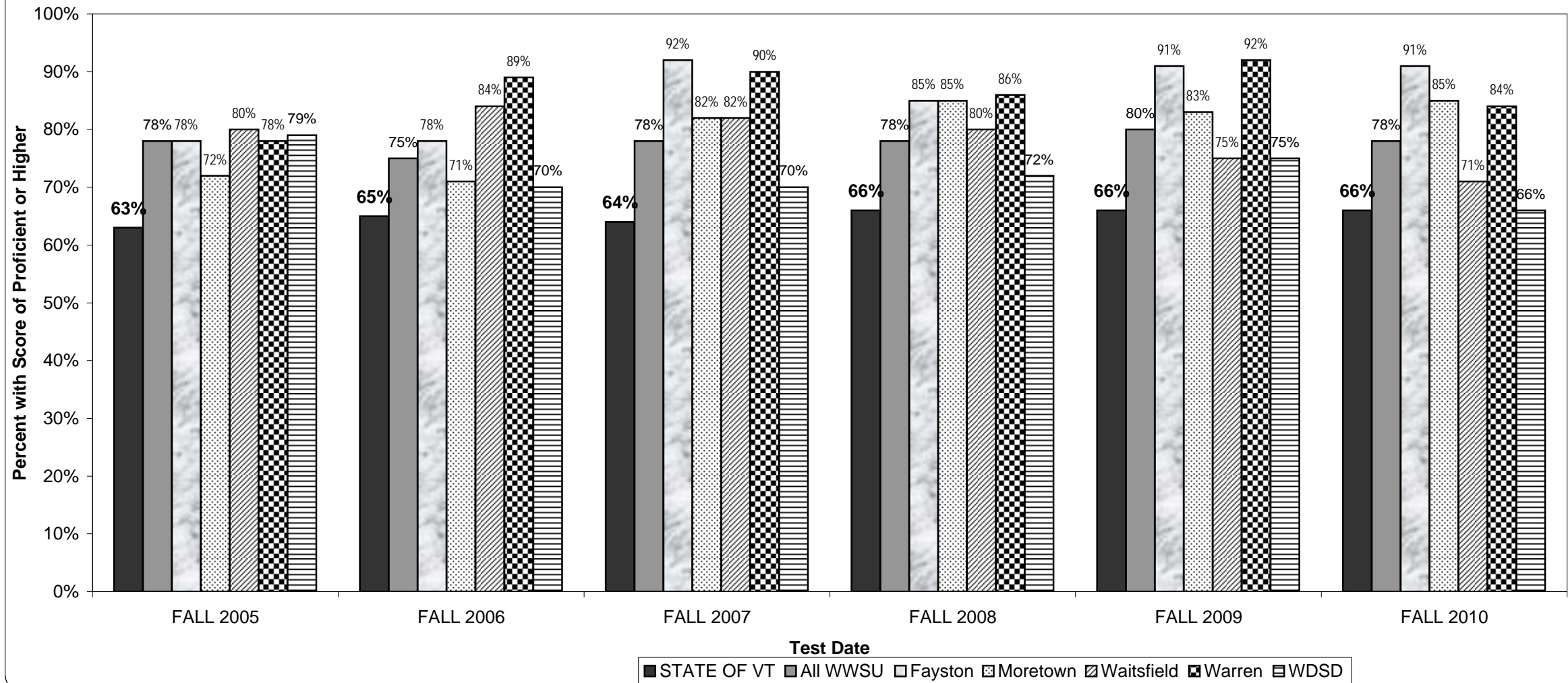

ALL STUDENTS**



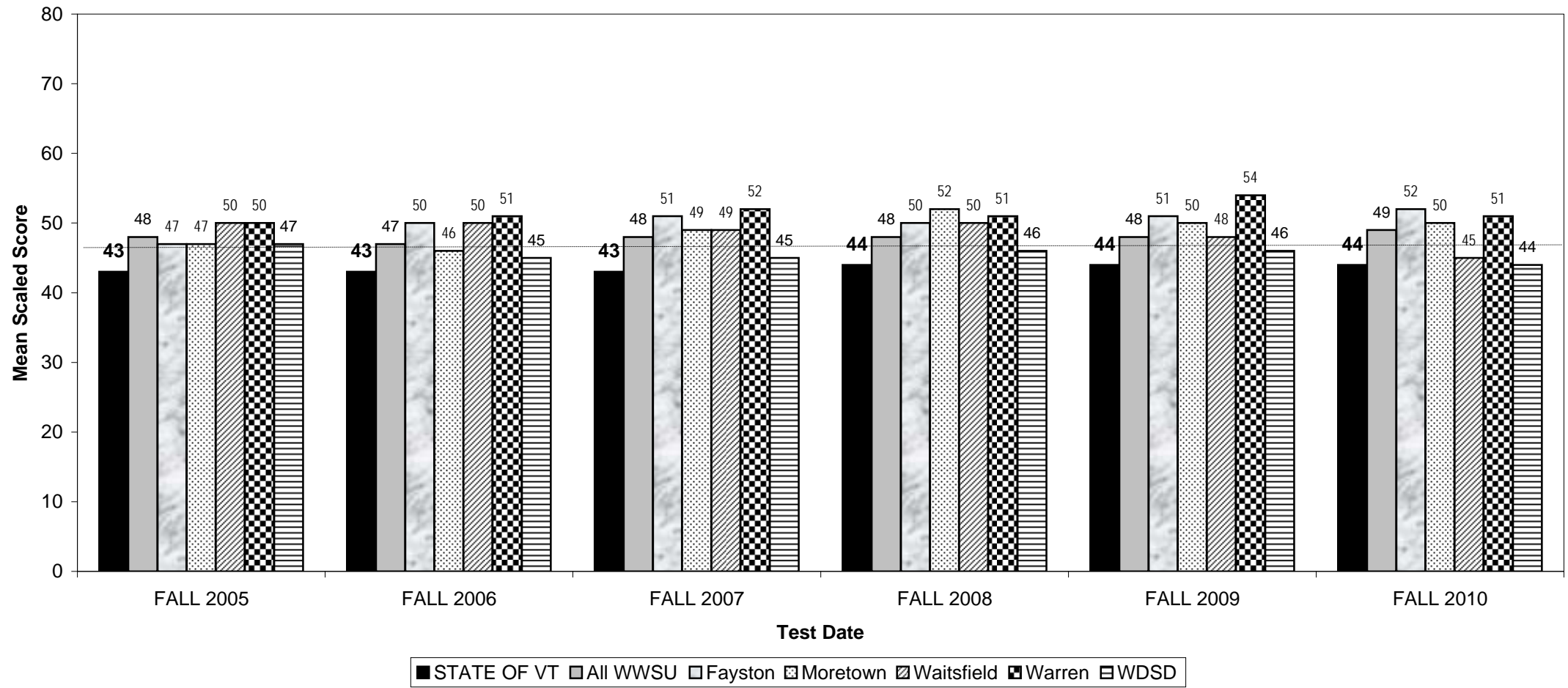
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

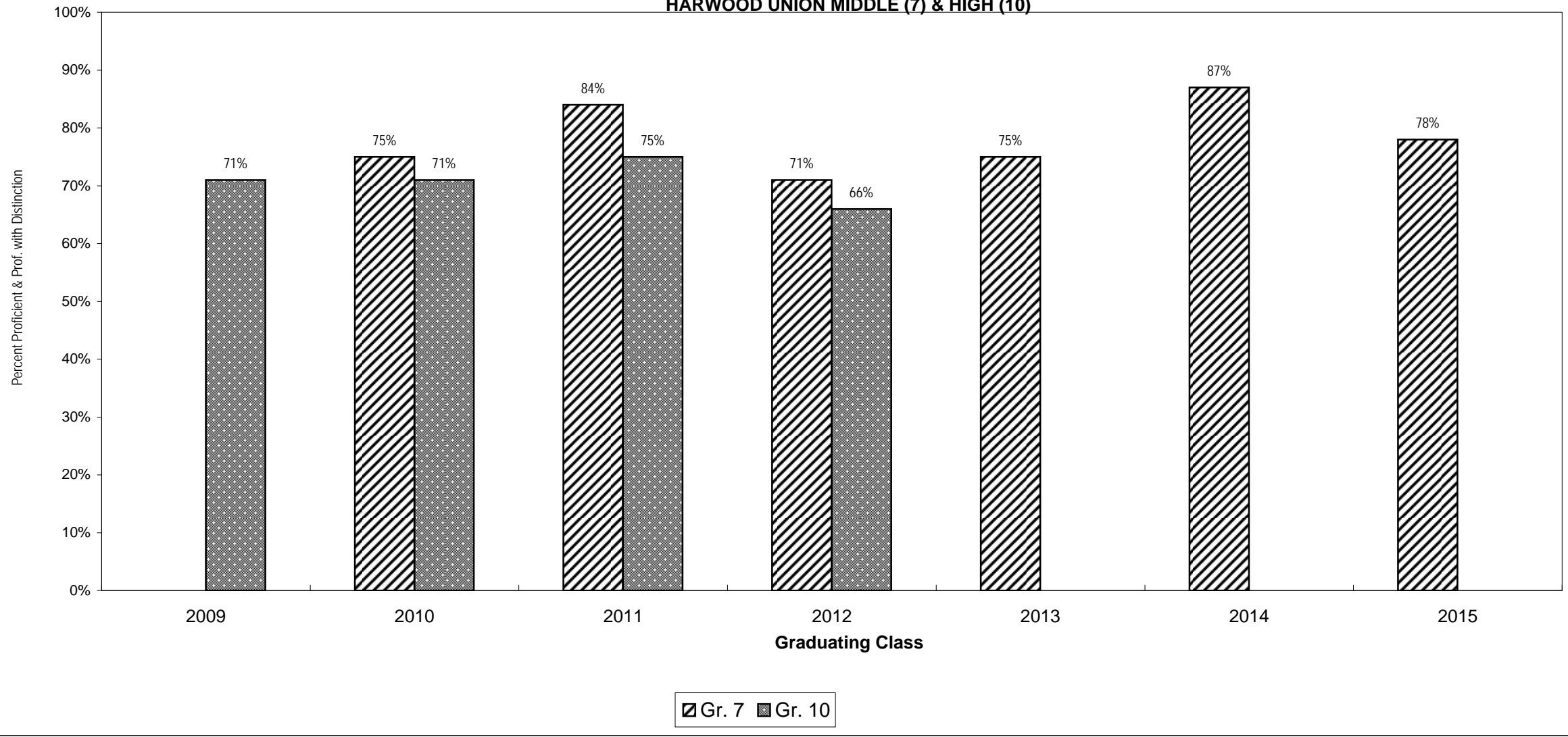

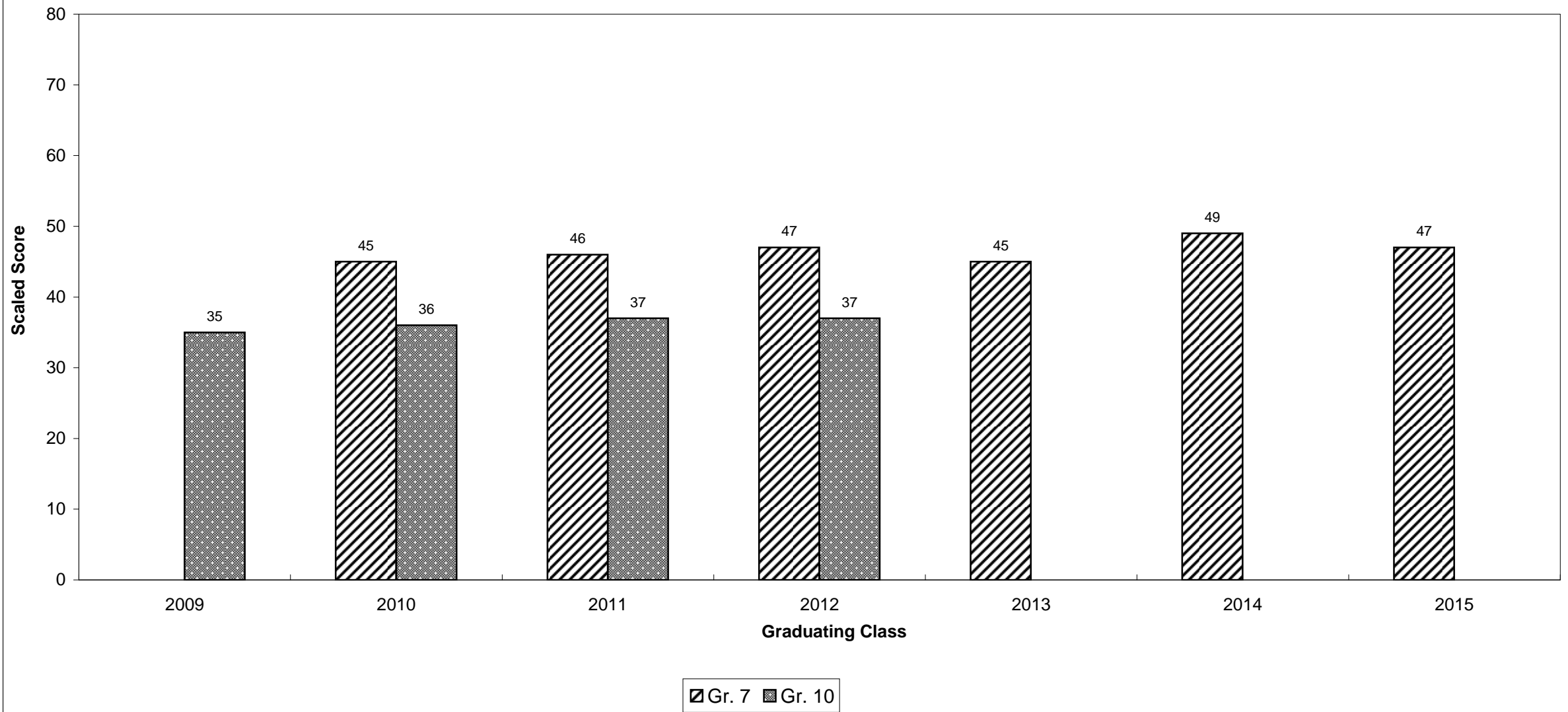

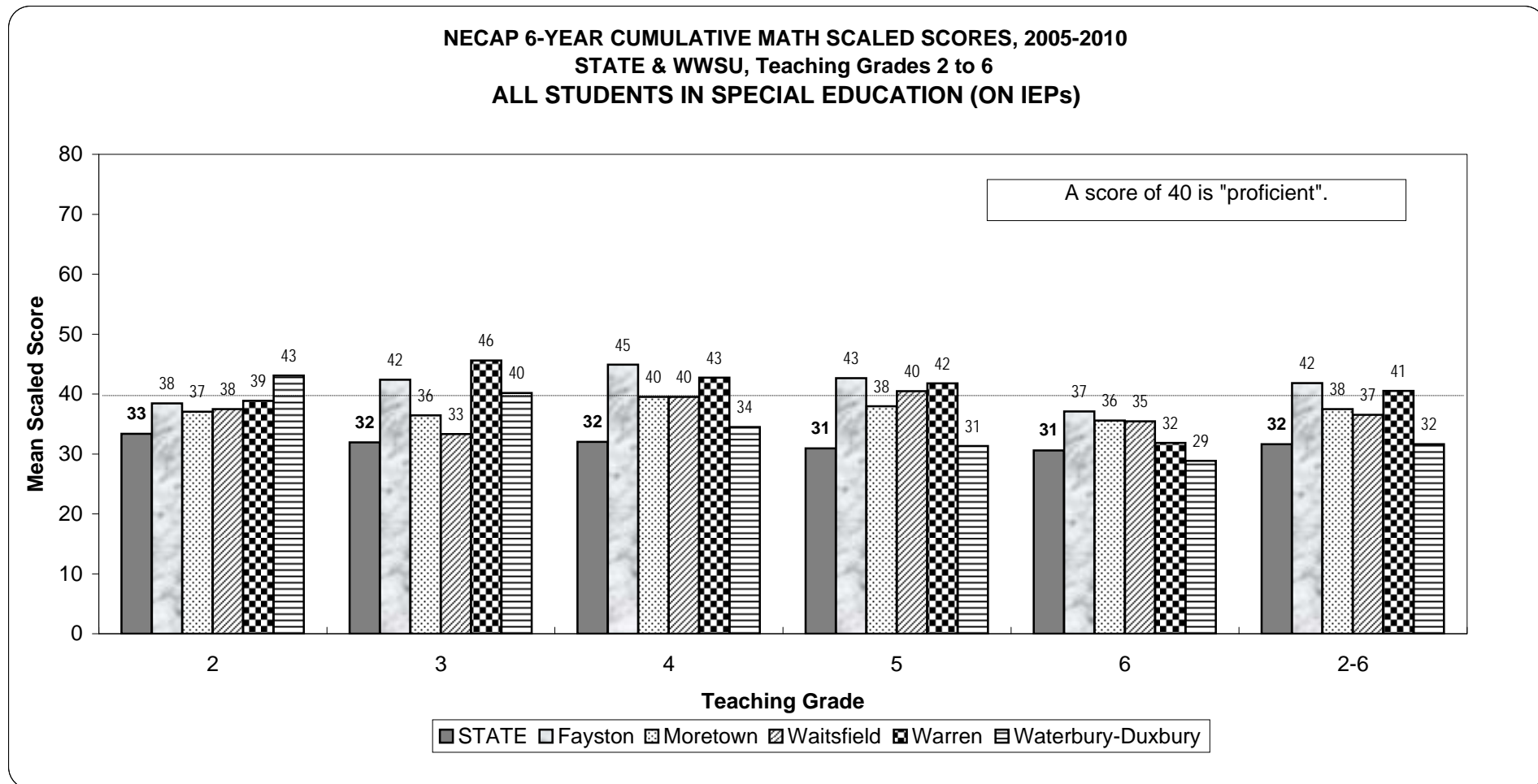

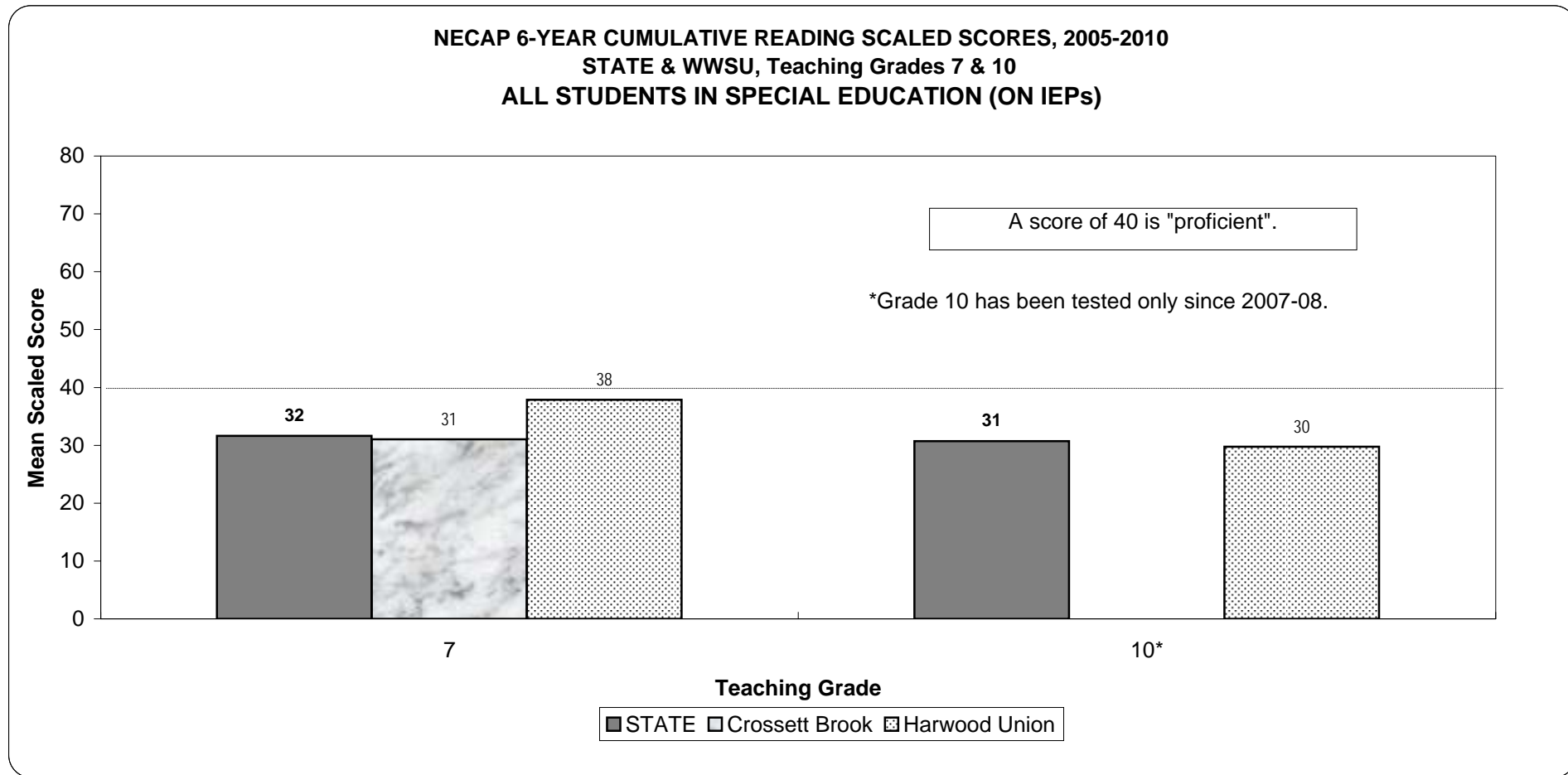
