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
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



Teaching Grade 10, ALL STUDENTS**




MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES







Teaching Grade 7, ALL STUDENTS**




**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

Teaching Grade 7, ALL STUDENTS**




**MULTI-YEAR NECAP MATH SCORES





ALL STUDENTS**




**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

ALL STUDENTS**



ALL STUDENTS**












**FALL 2012 NECAP MATH SCORES









**FALL 2012 NECAP READING SCORES
