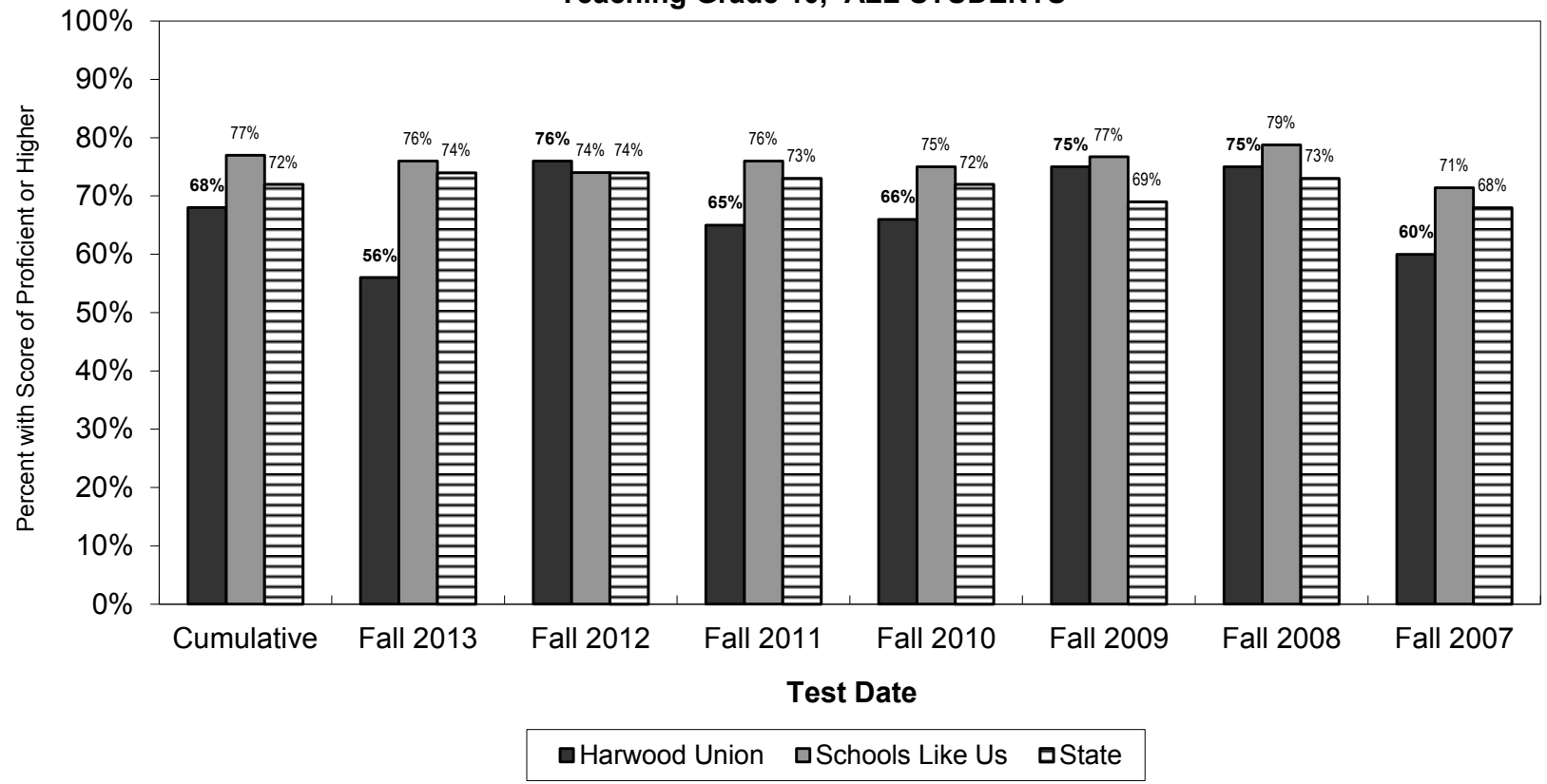

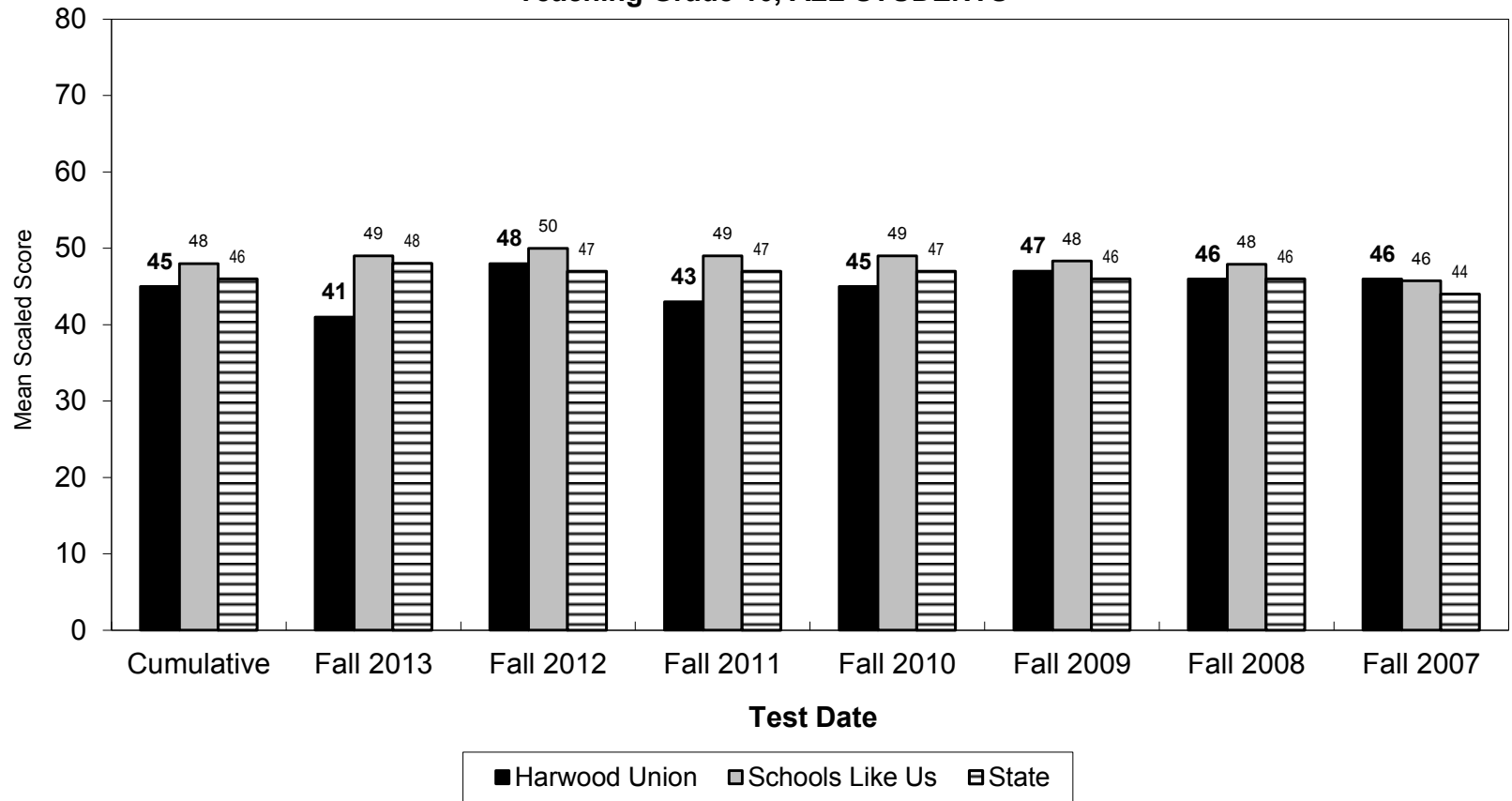

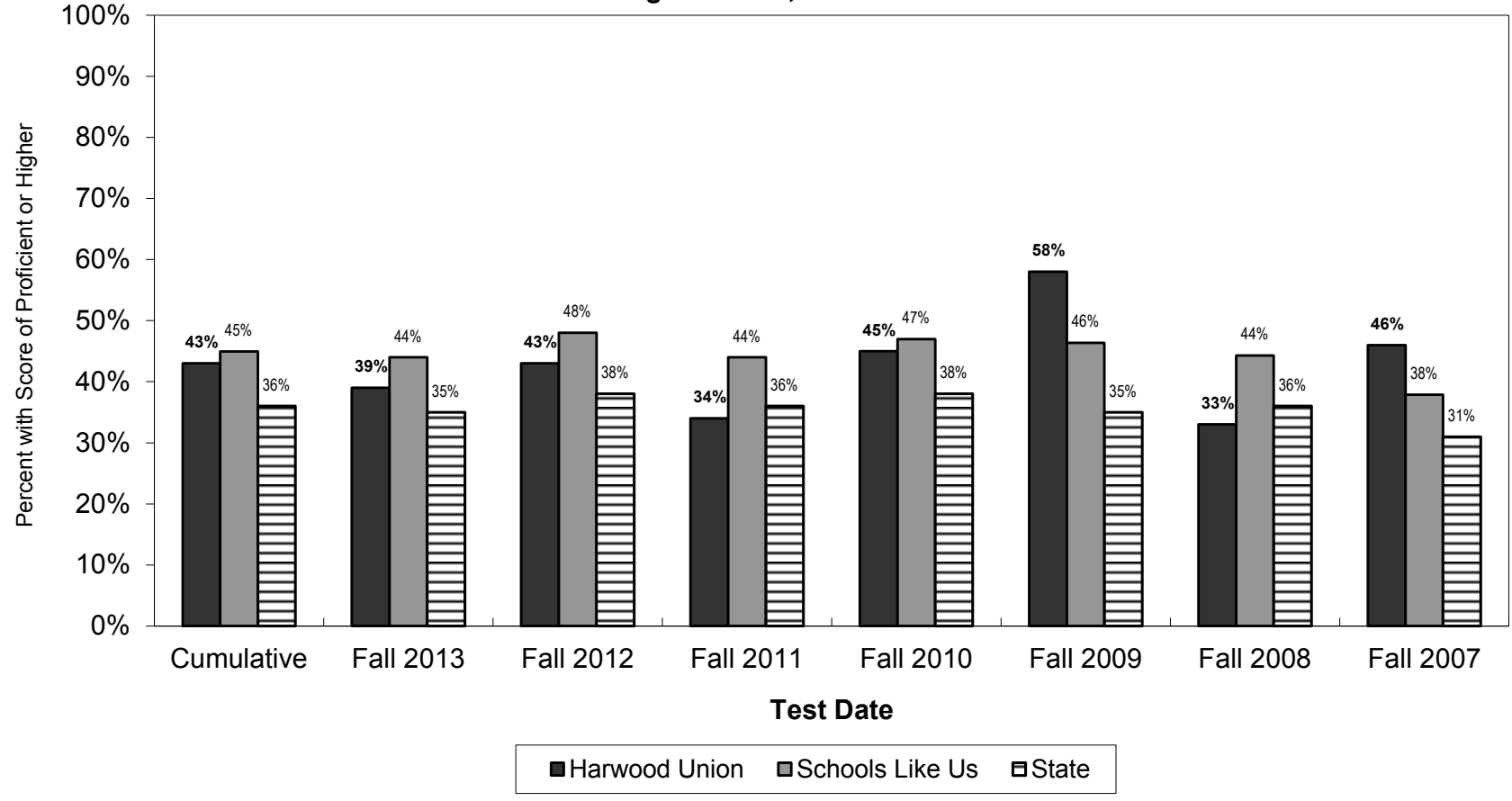

Teaching Grade 10, ALL STUDENTS**

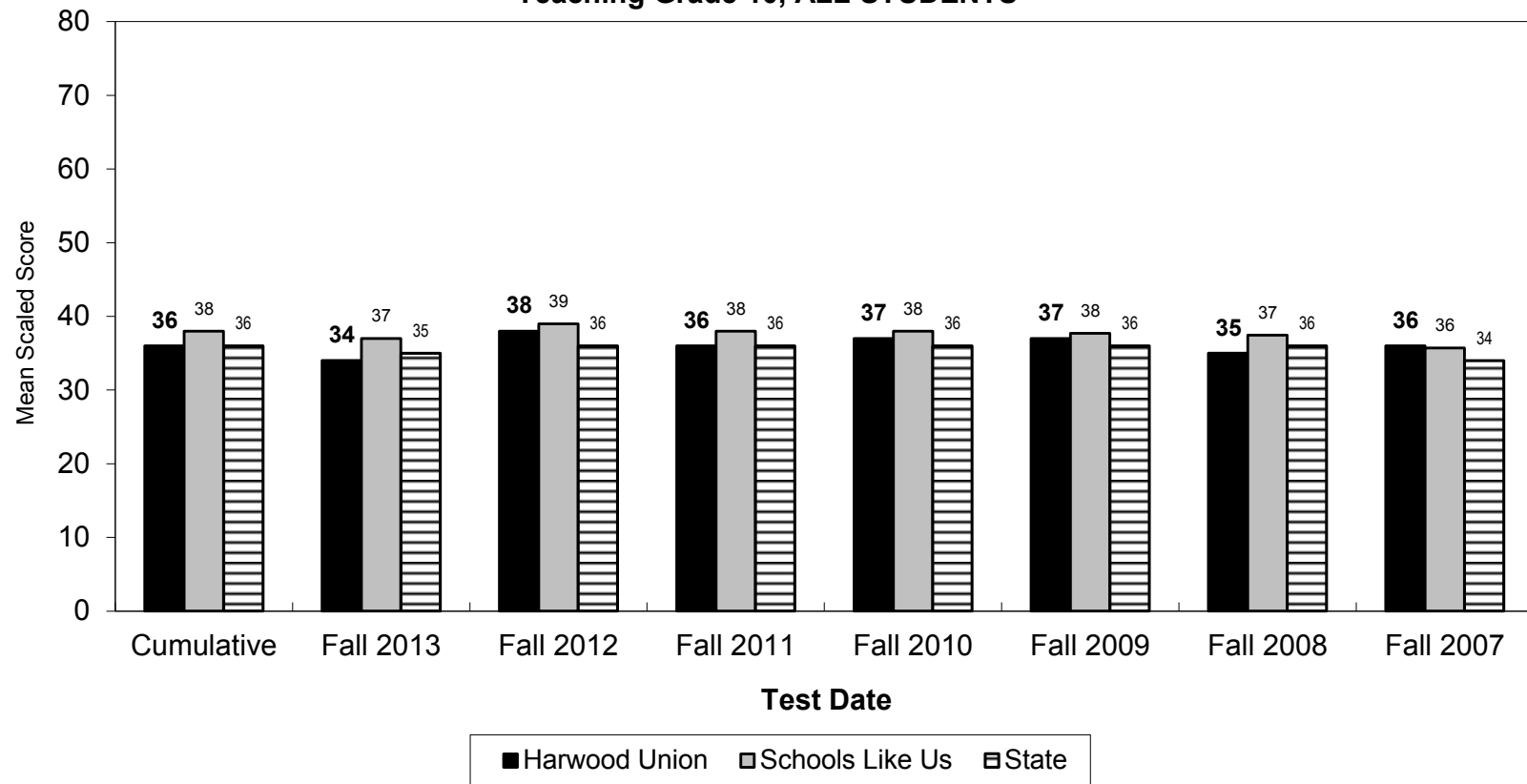


**MULTI-YEAR NECAP MATH SCORES

Teaching Grade 10, ALL STUDENTS**





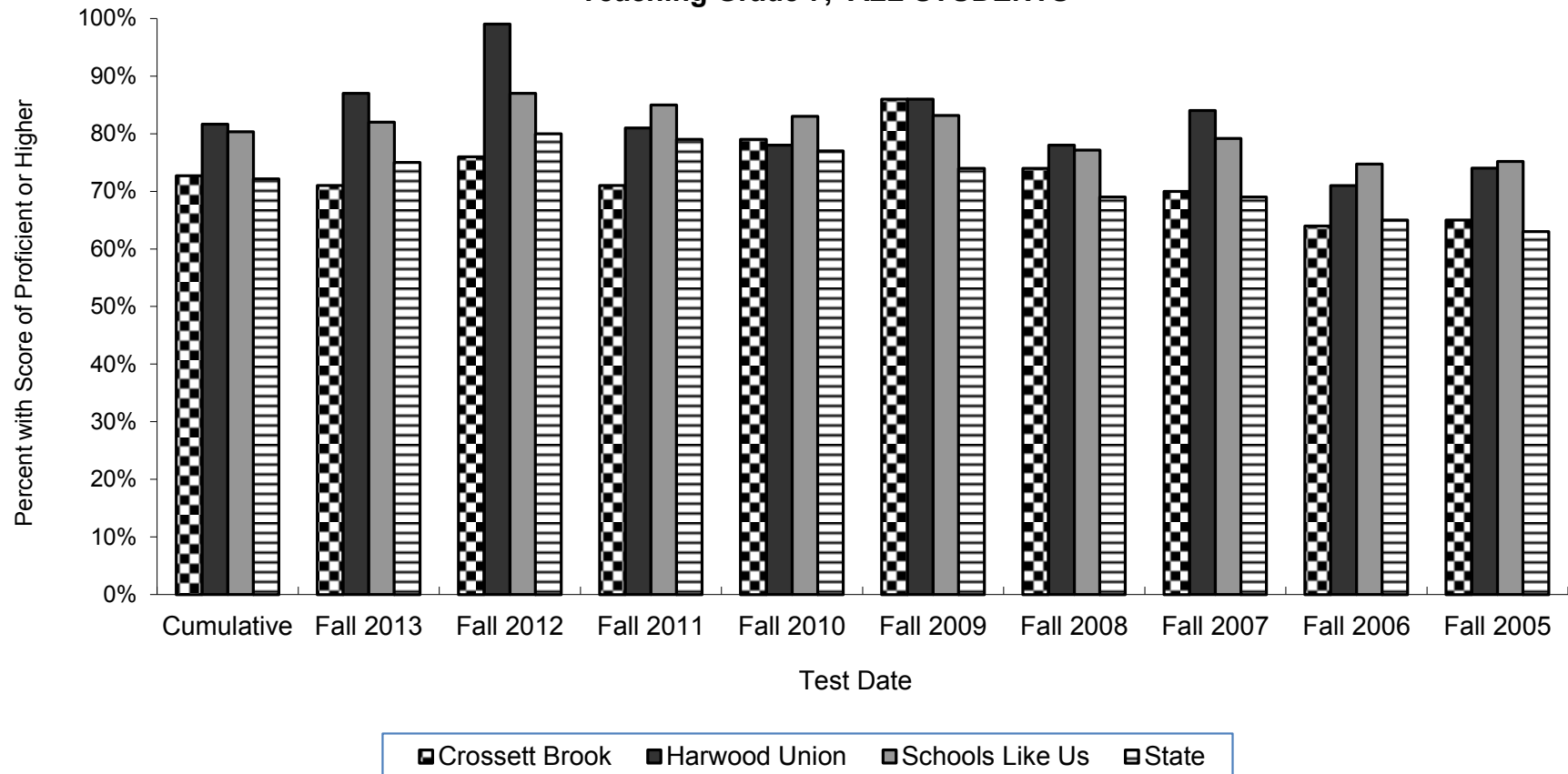

Teaching Grade 10, ALL STUDENTS**



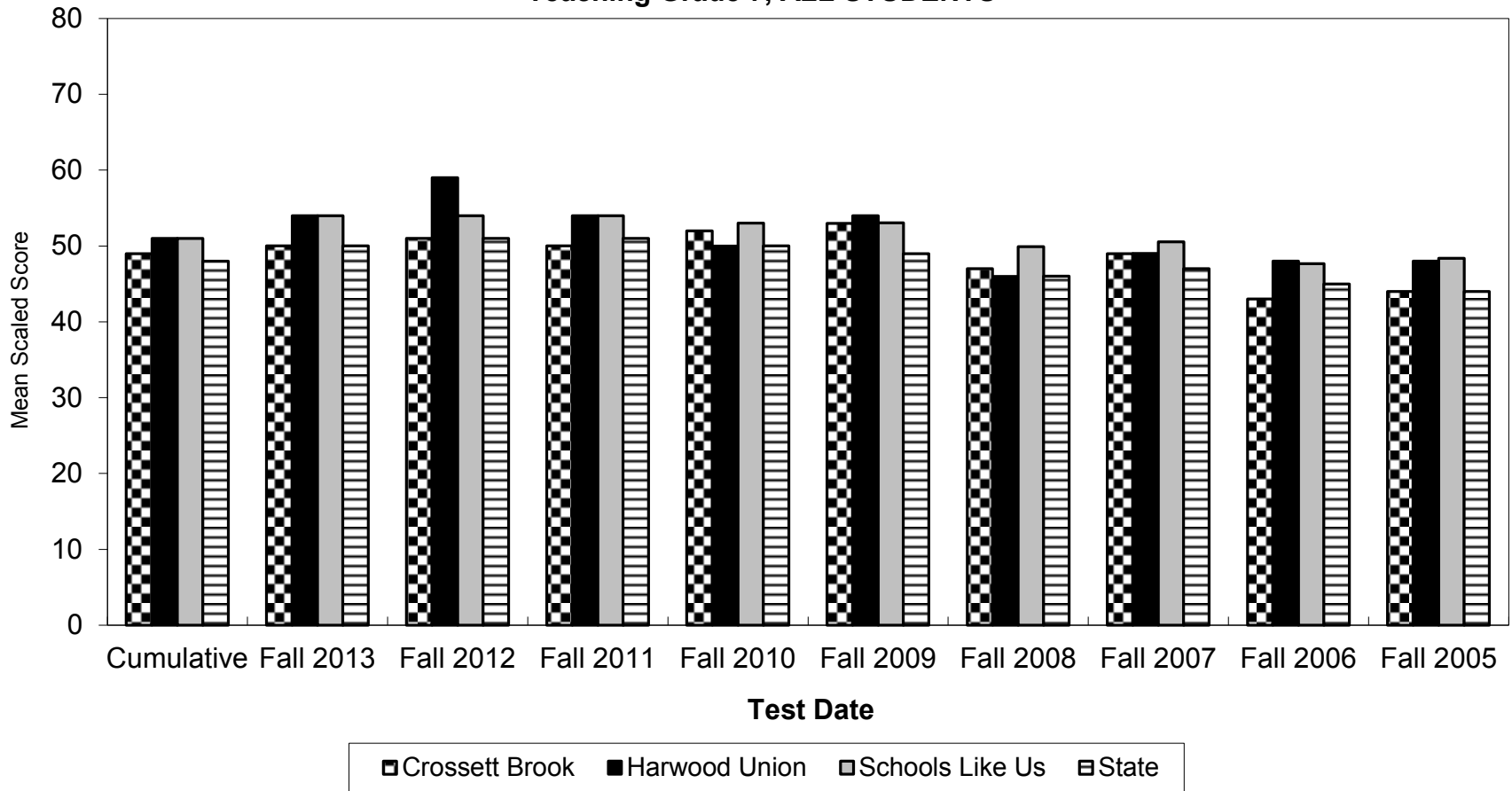




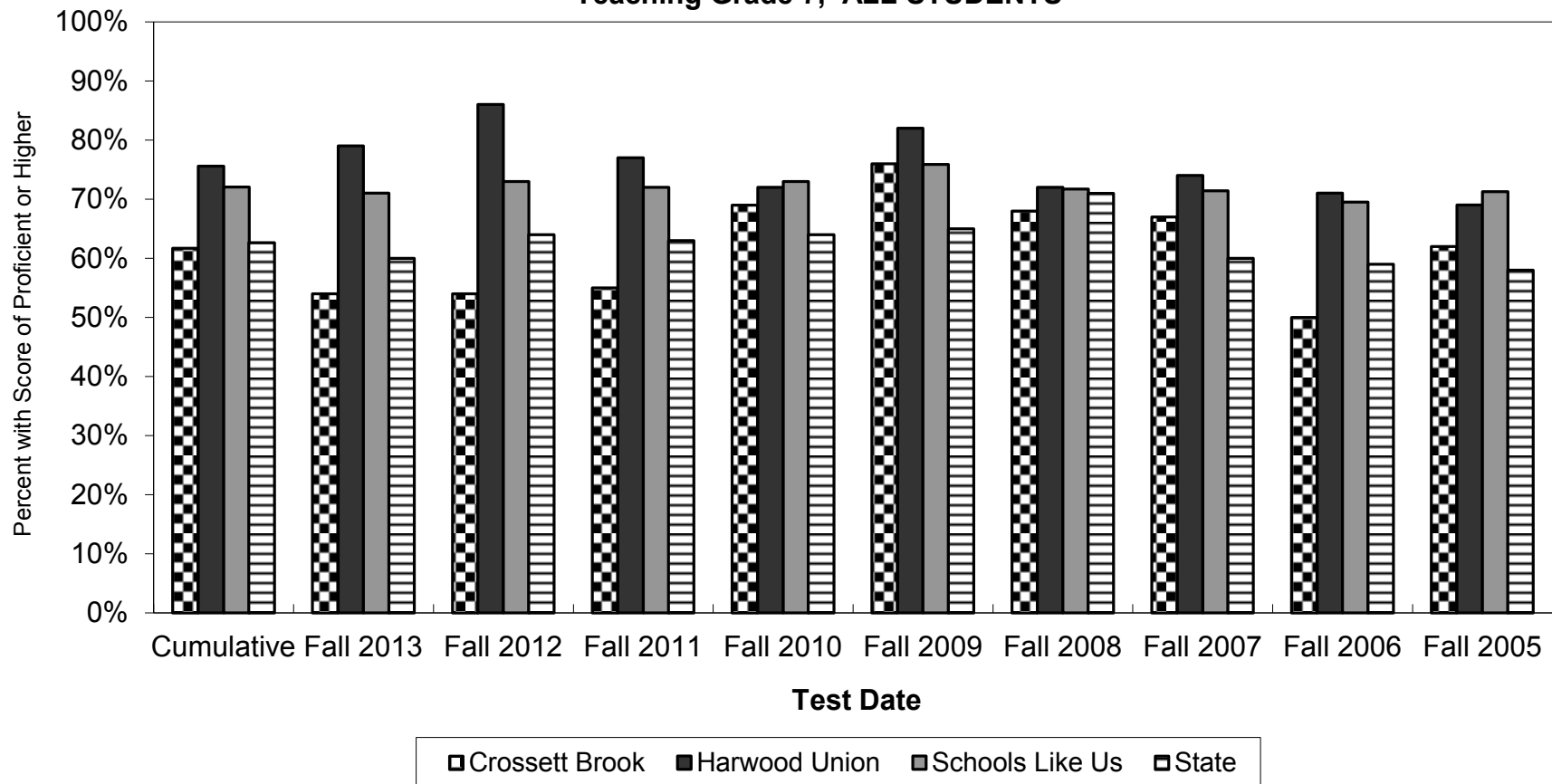
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

Teaching Grade 7, ALL STUDENTS**



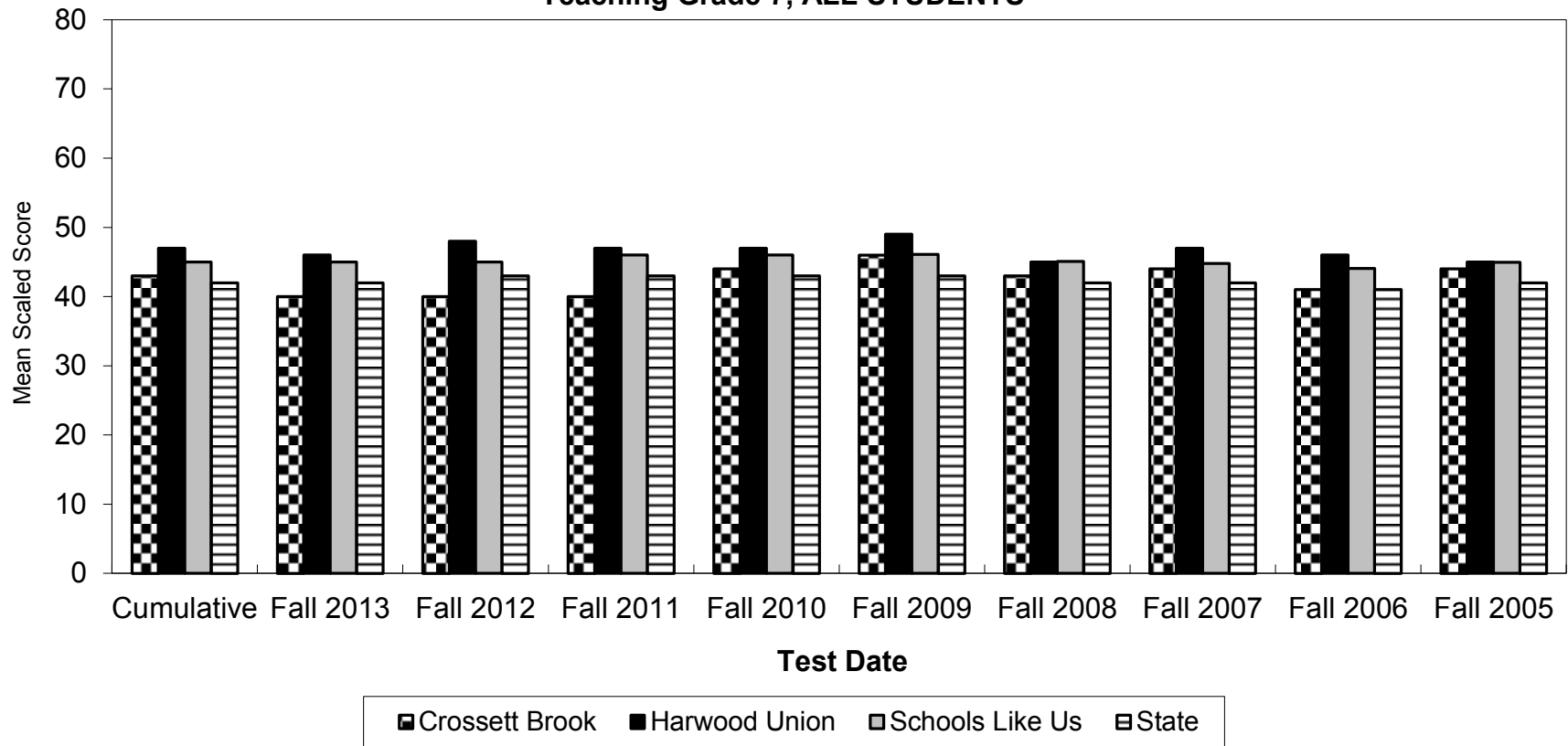

Teaching Grade 7, ALL STUDENTS**



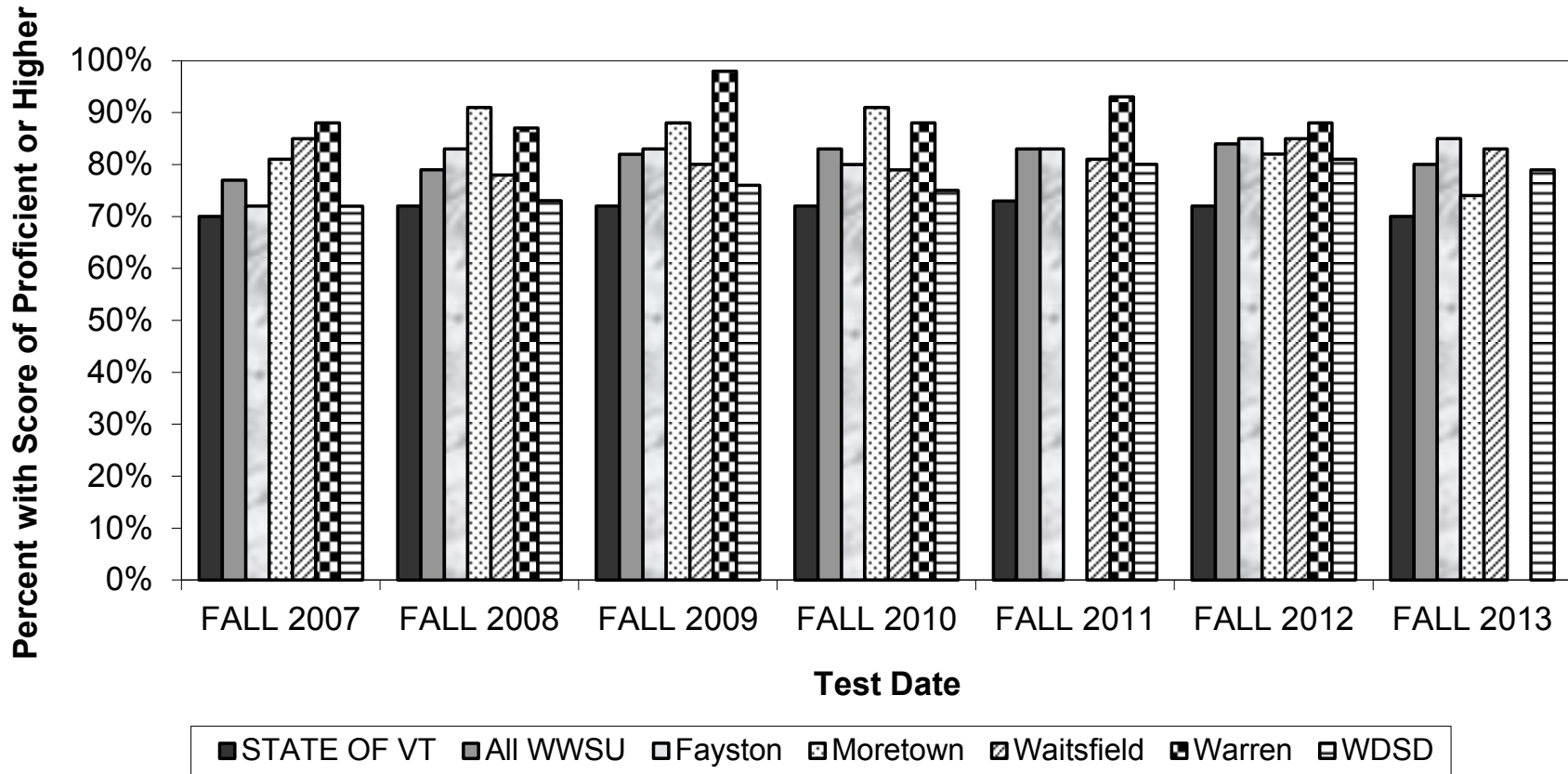

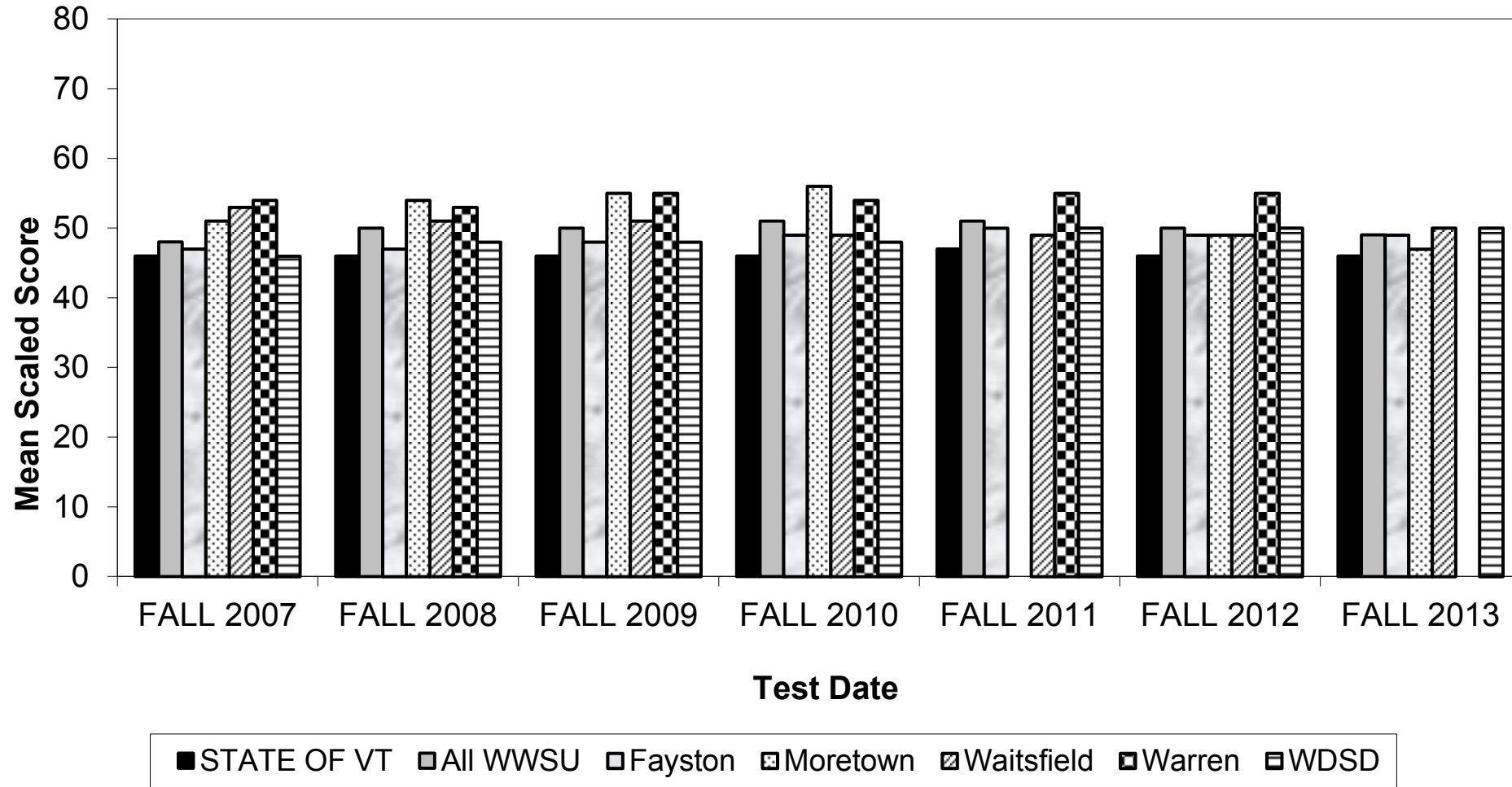

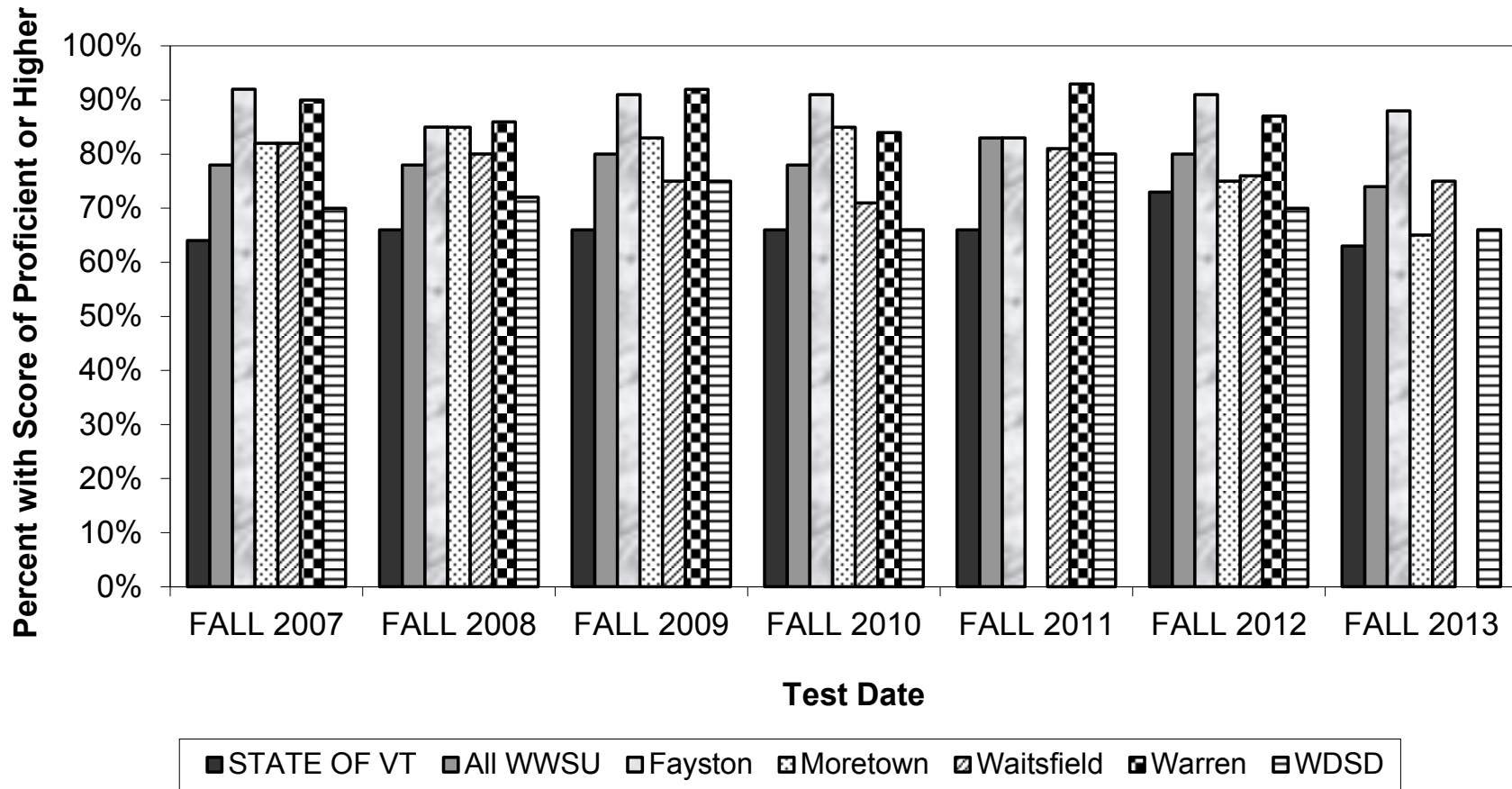
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

ALL STUDENTS**



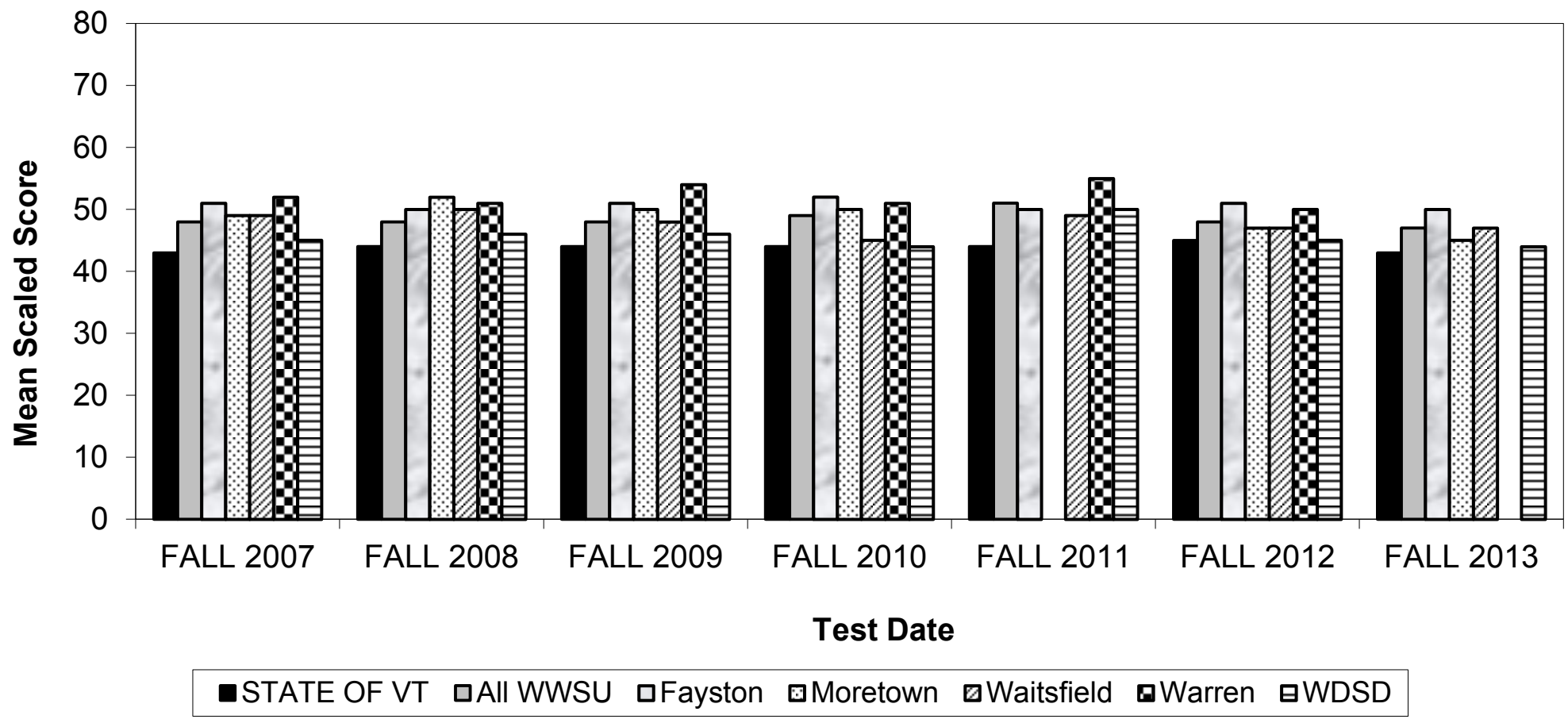
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

ALL STUDENTS**



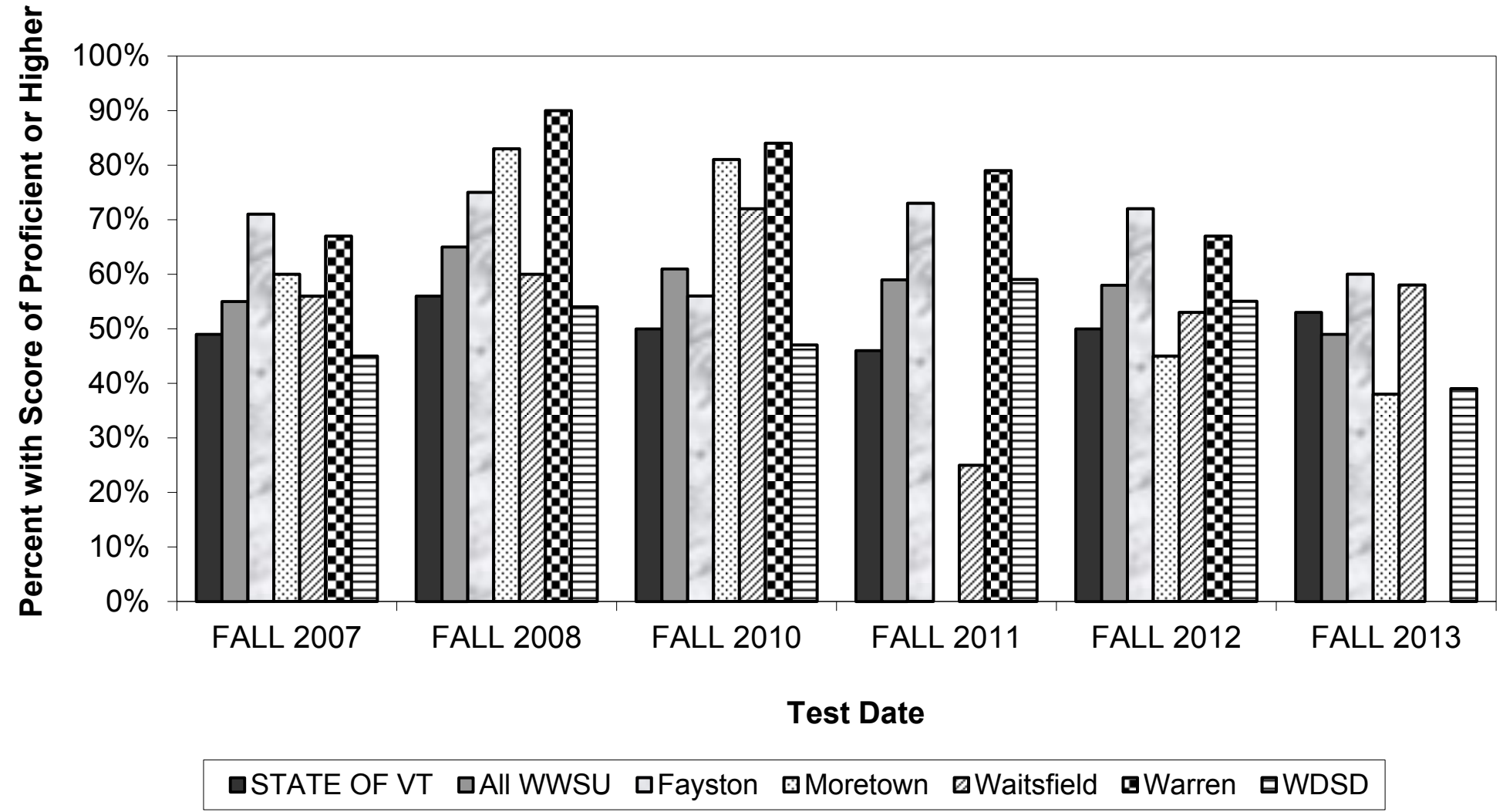
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP MATH SCORES

ALL STUDENTS**



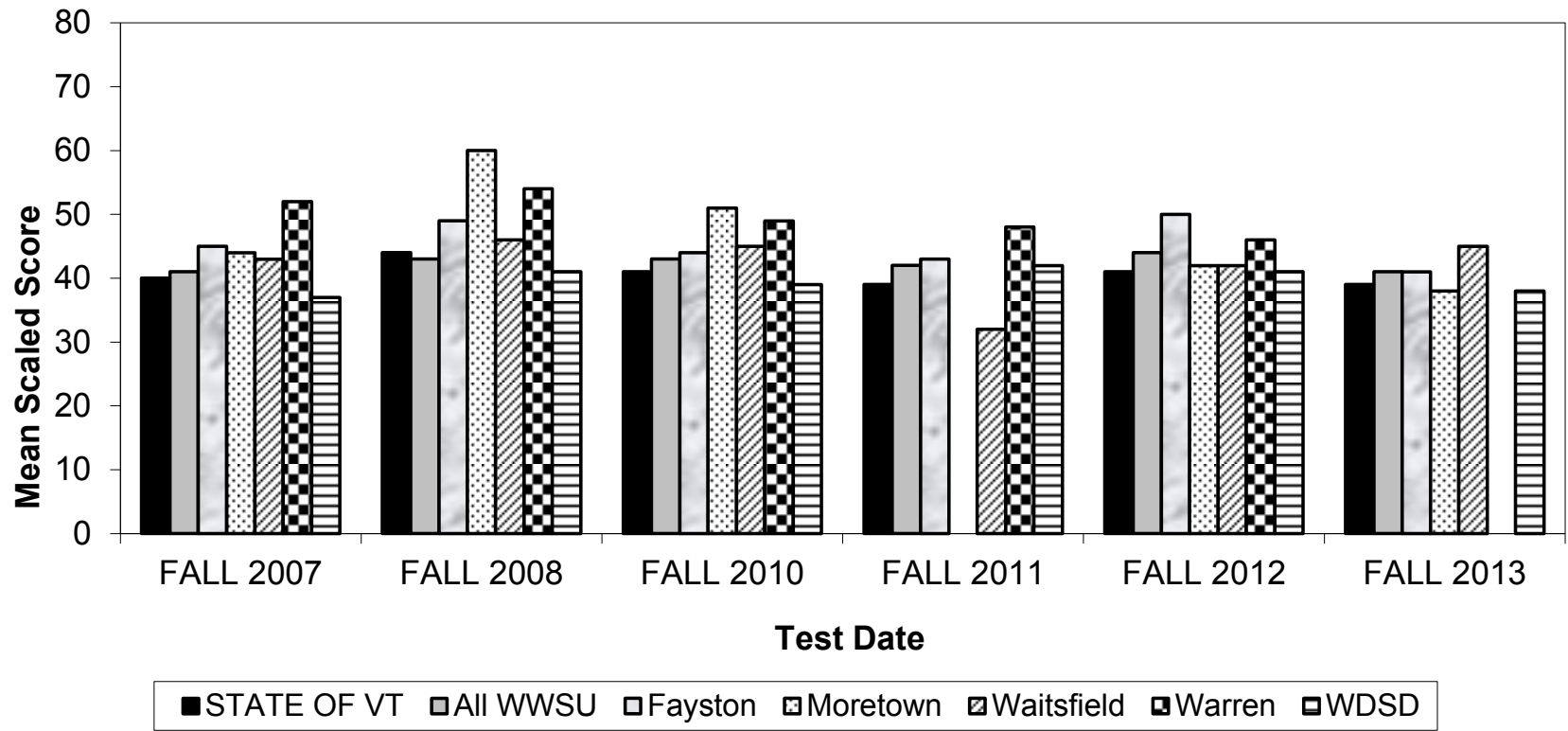

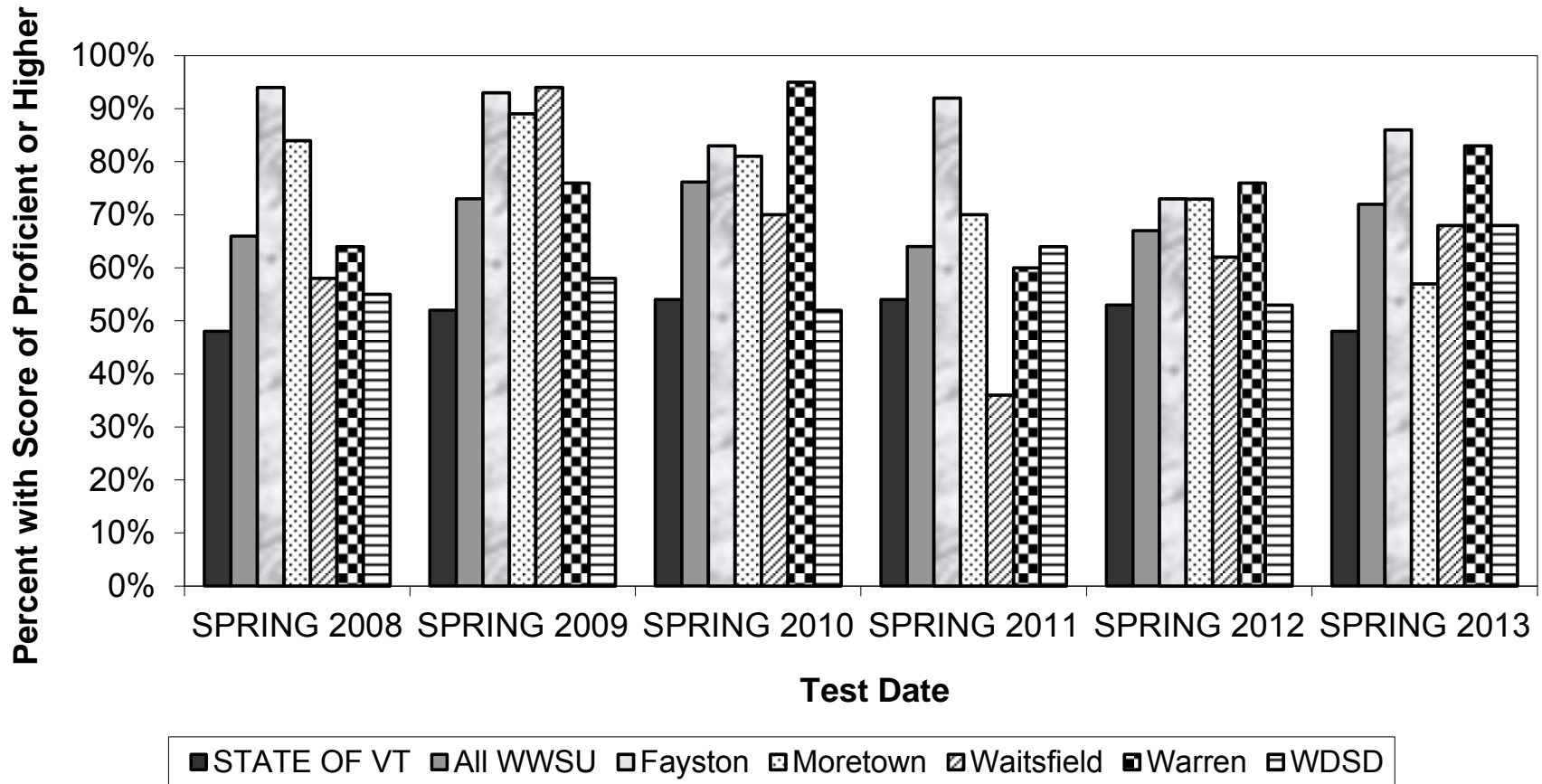

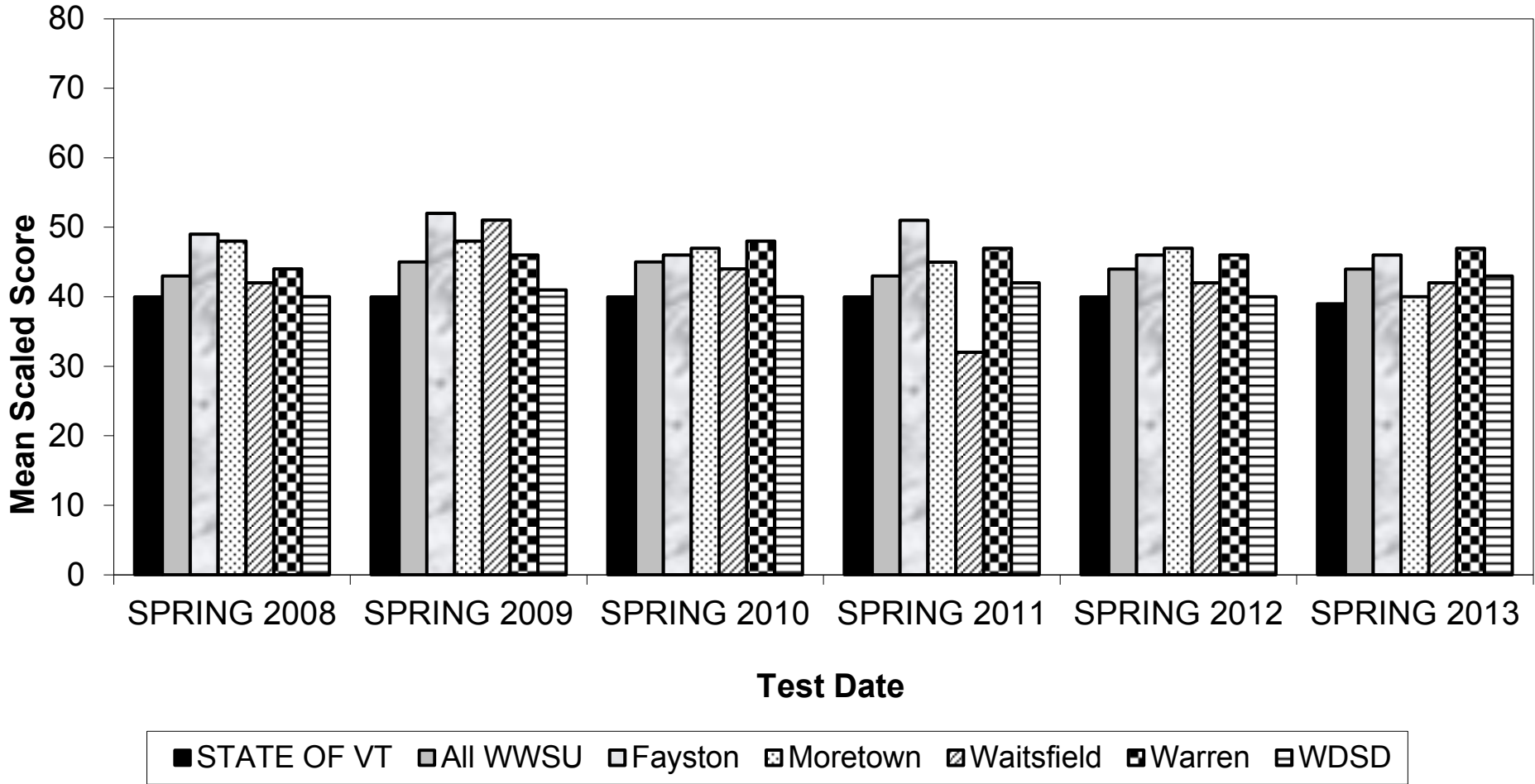

ALL STUDENTS**

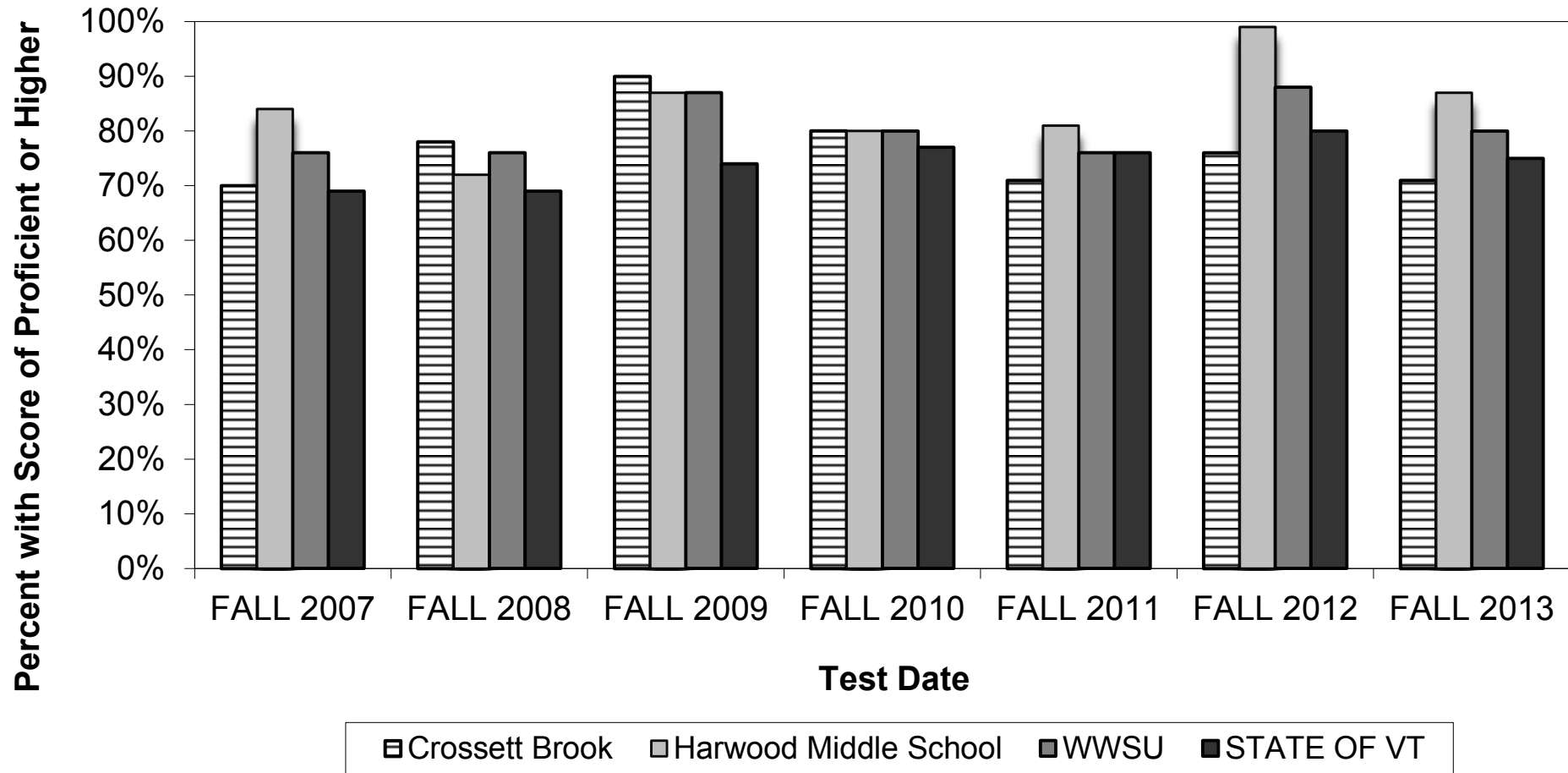

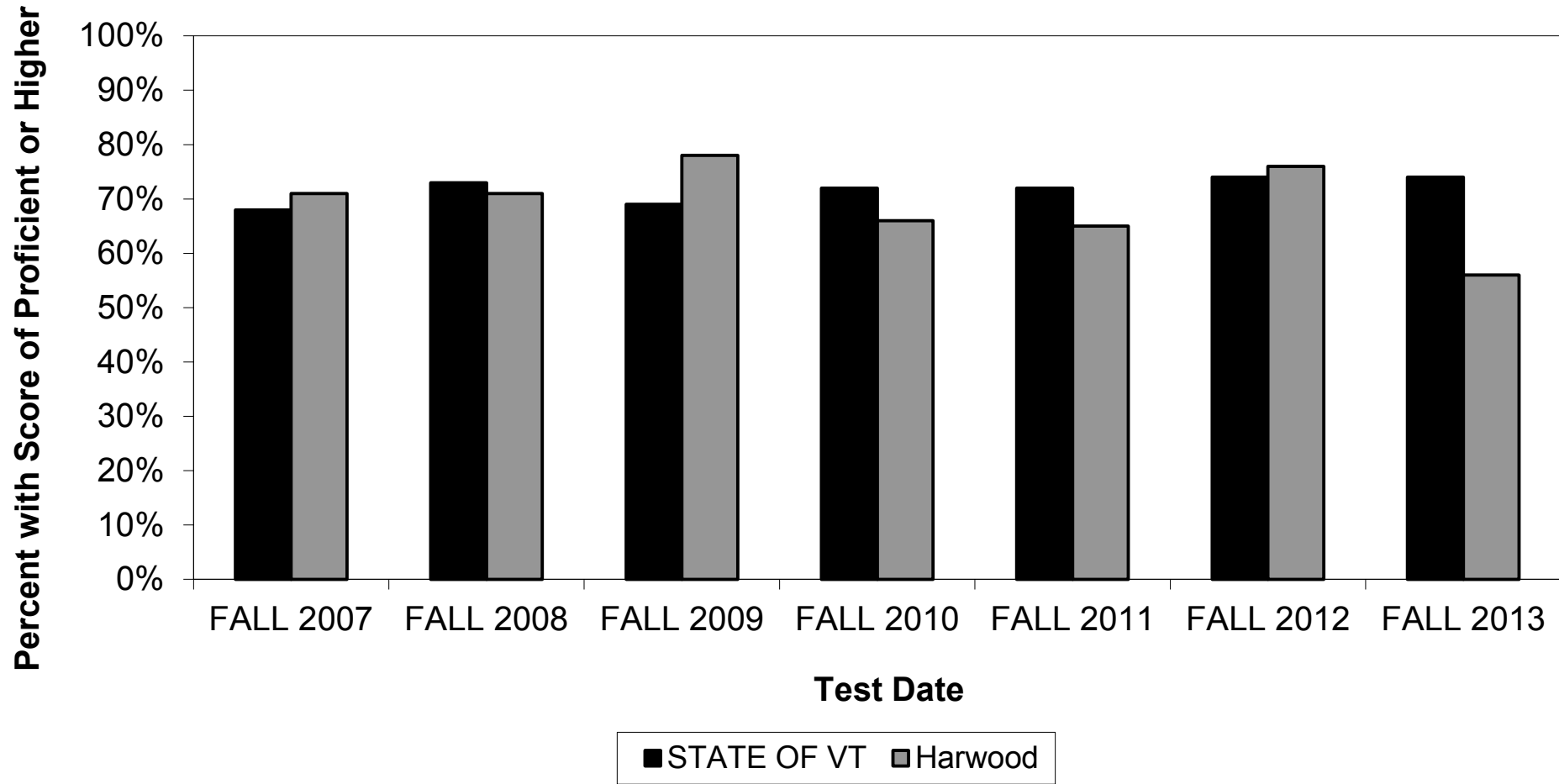
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP SCIENCE SCORES

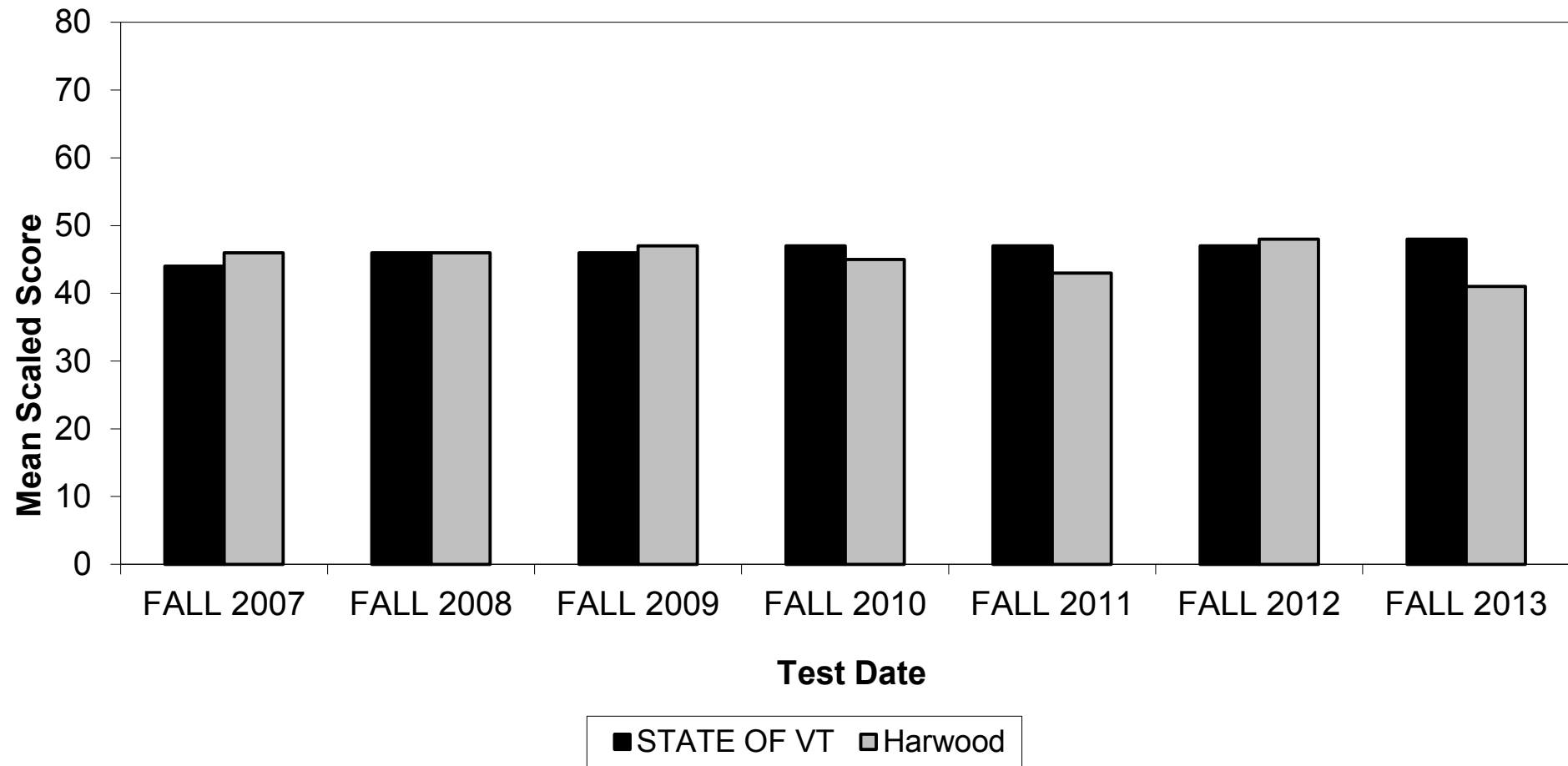

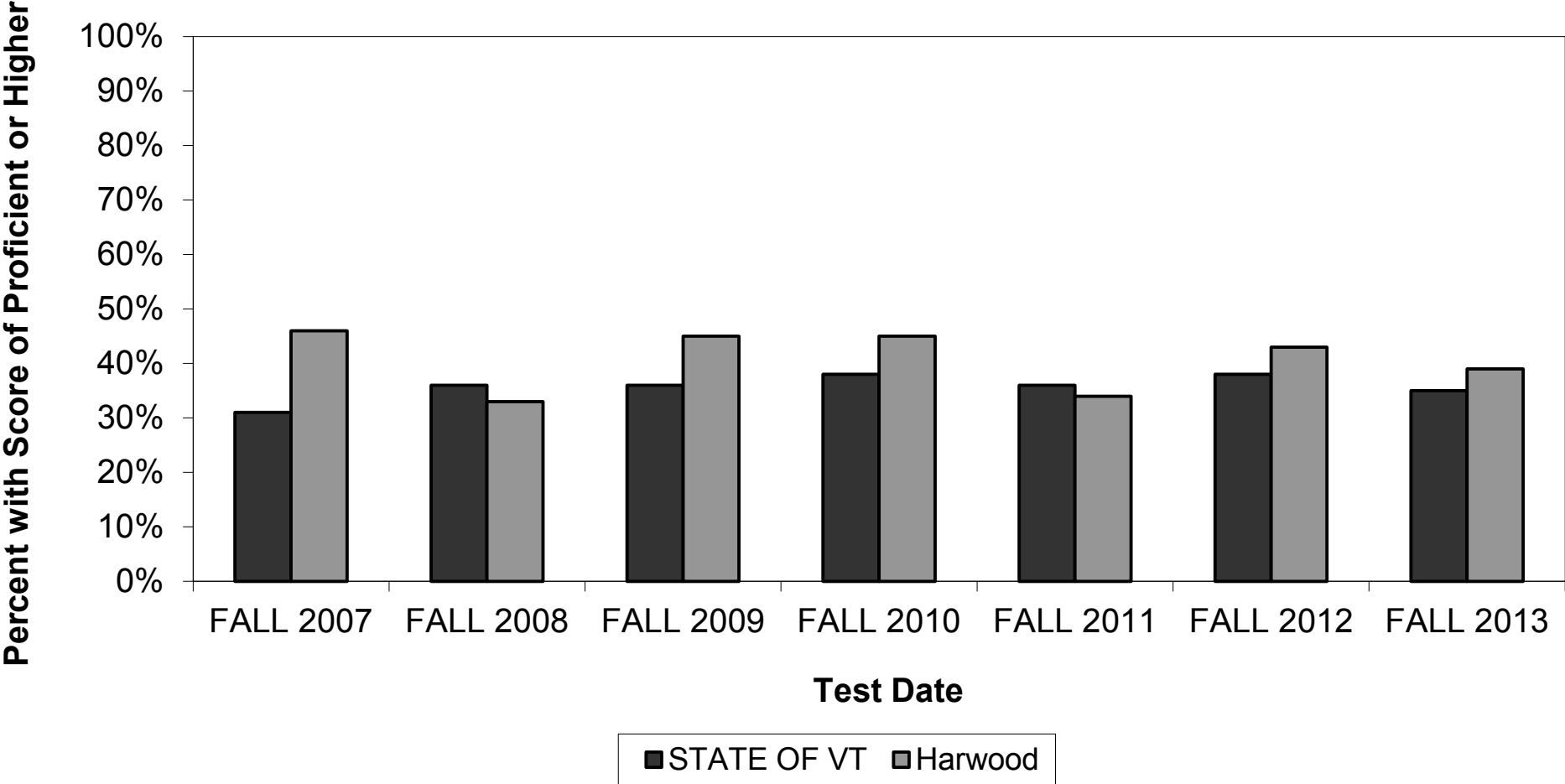
**MULTI-YEAR NECAP READING SCORES

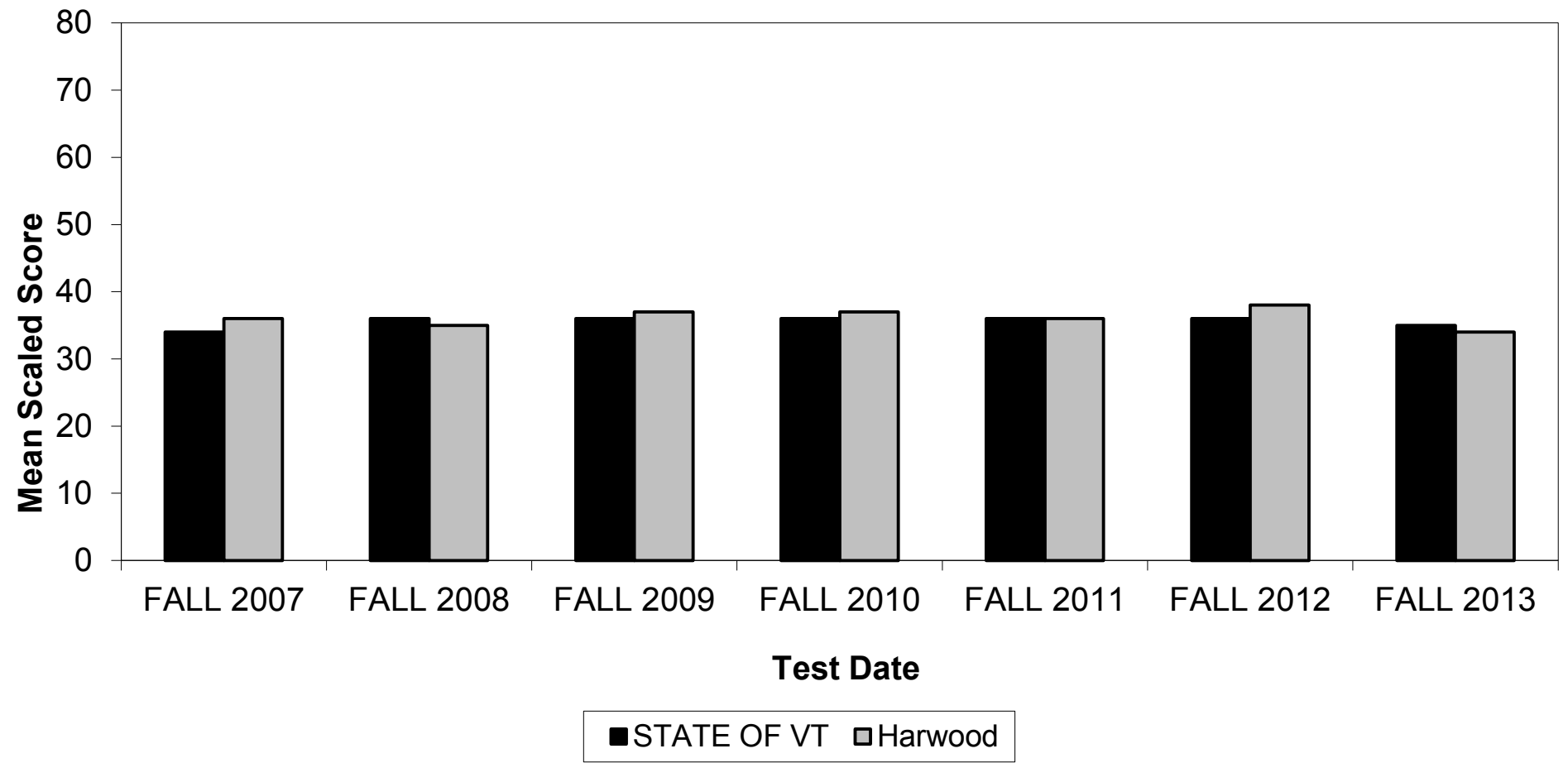

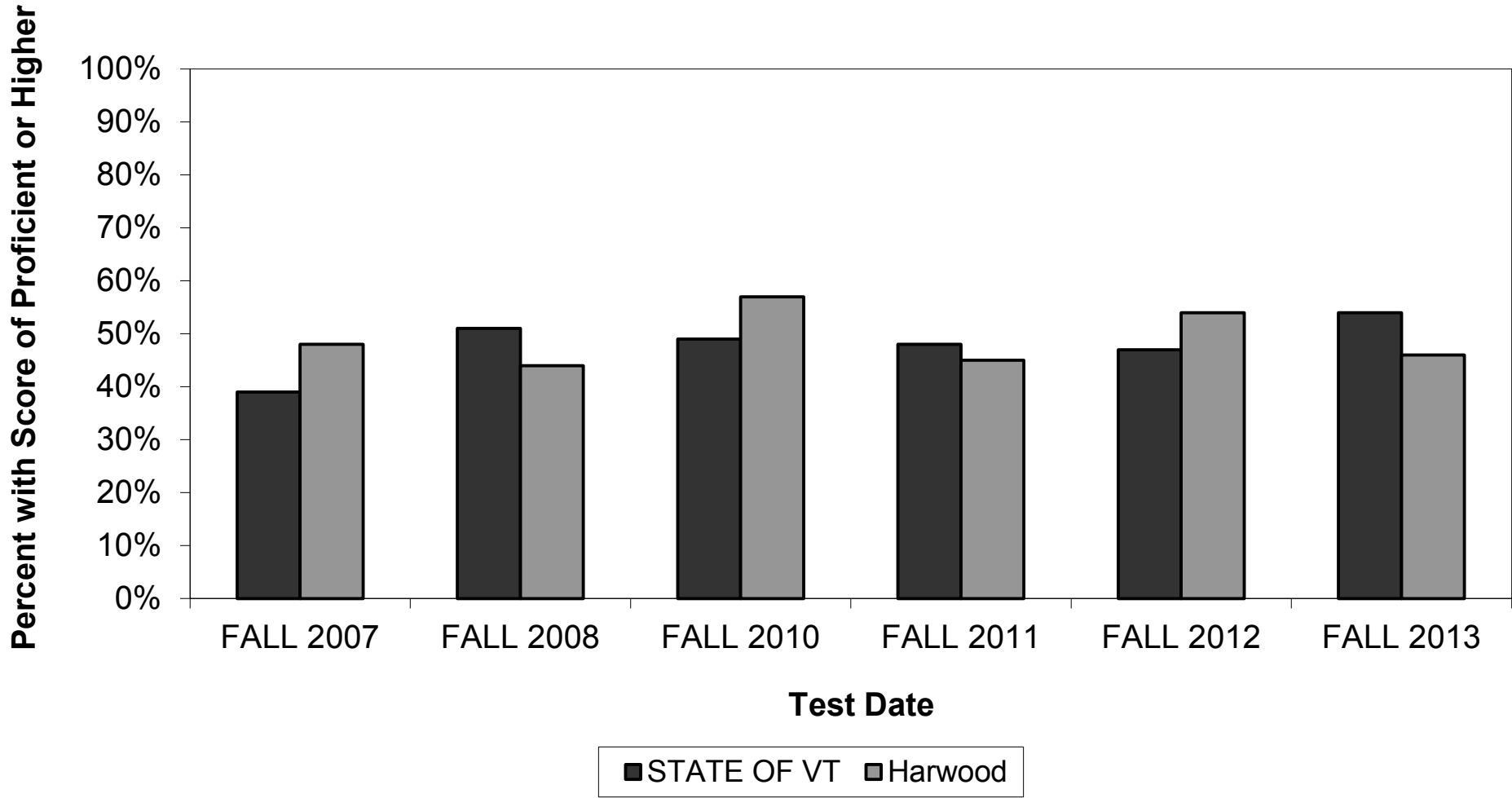

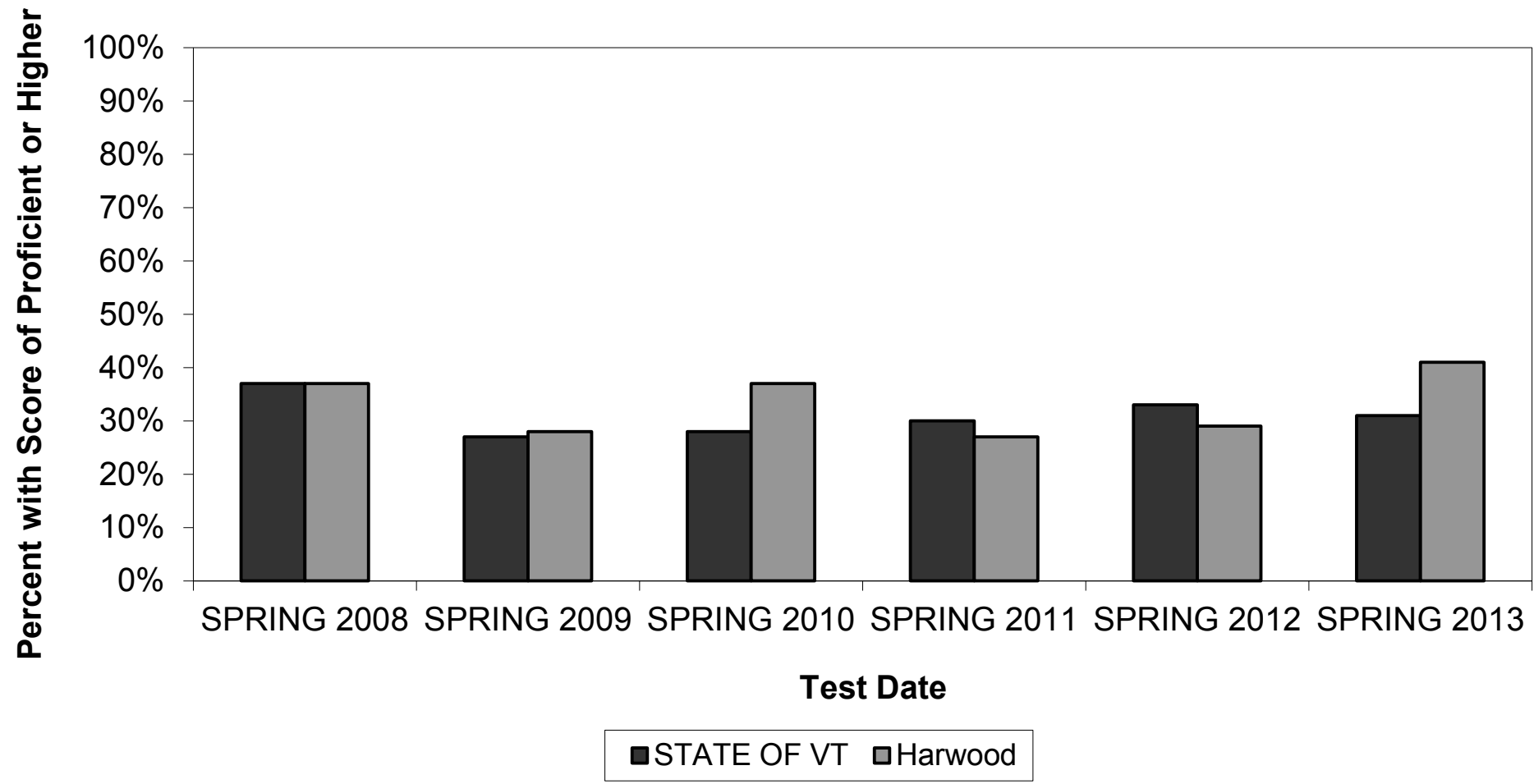


**MULTI-YEAR NECAP WRITING SCORES

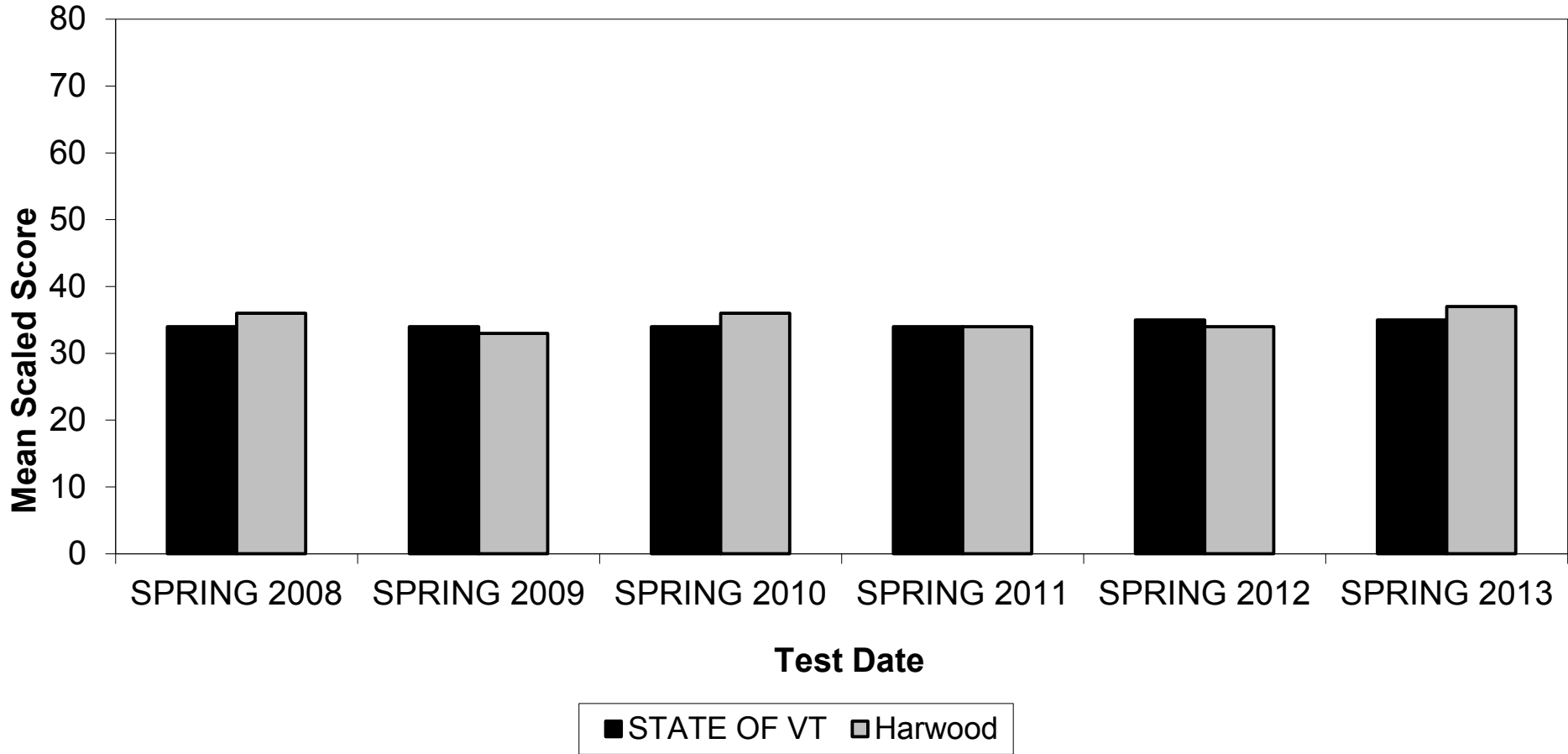




**MULTI-YEAR NECAP SCIENCE SCORES

New England Common Assessment Program (NECAP) By "Teaching Grade", Grades 2 to 7 Waterbury-Duxbury - 9 Years At-A-Glance

The NECAP tests grade 3 to 8 students in October, and results are reported here by "teaching grade", that is, by the grade the students were in the previous school year. NECAP results are shown in two ways; one, the percentage of students who met or exceeded the pre-determined standard of proficiency, by subject; and two, the average score for each subject. The percentage achieving the proficiency standard can fluctuate greatly when a large number of students just barely "meet the standard" ( a score of 40) one year, and then just barely miss it the next year. When this happens, the percentage score may drop or rise sharply, although the average score is barely different. For this reason, it is best to keep an eye on both "% proficient" and actual scores in drawing conclusions.

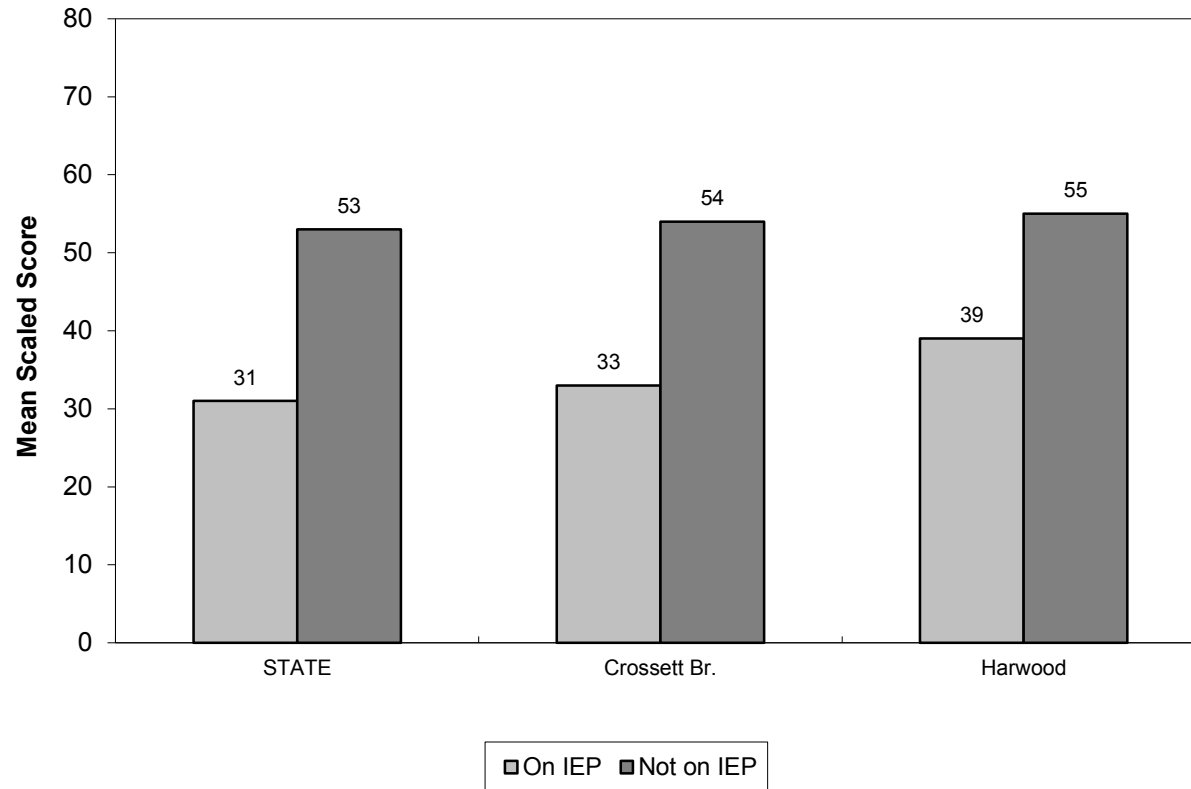




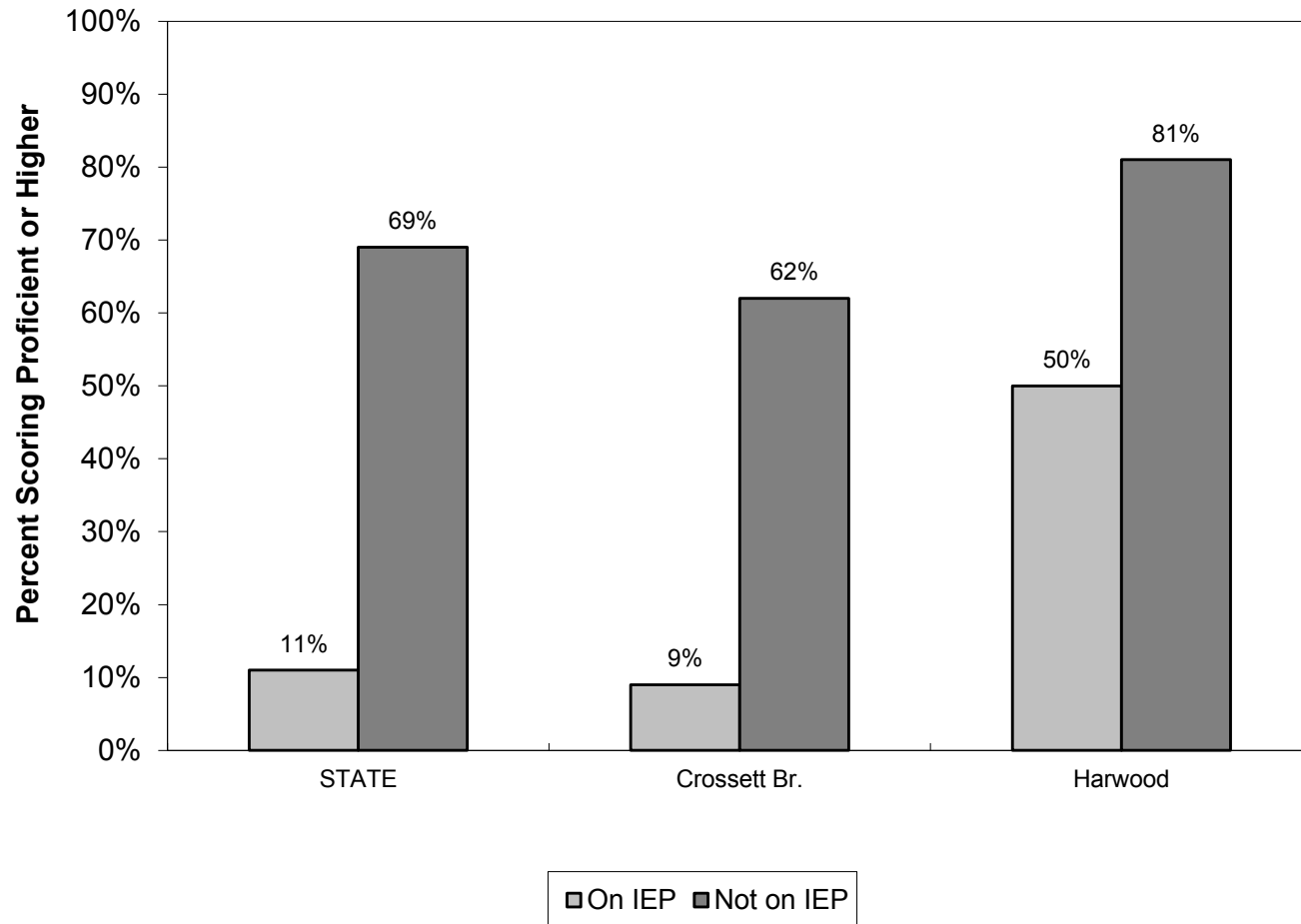
**FALL 2013 NECAP READING SCORES

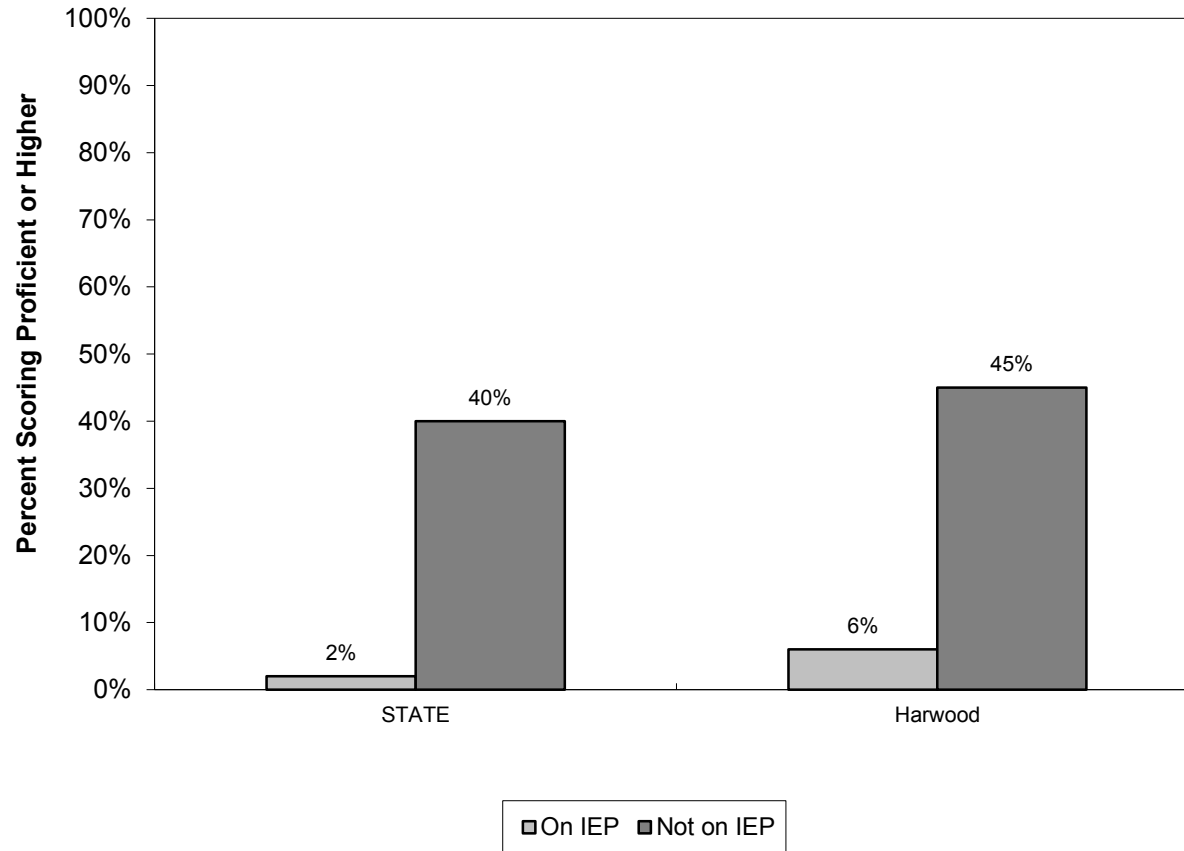
