WASHINGTON WEST SUPERVISORY UNION NOTICE TO PARENTS

In compliance with federal requirements under the Protection of Student Rights Act (PPRA), this is to provide parents with notice of specific parental rights of request with regard to the following:

- Policy on the rights of parents upon request to inspect any survey created by a third party (a survey funded by a non-U.S. Department of Education source). If the thirdparty survey involves questions related to political affiliations, mental or psychological problems, sexual behavior and attitudes, illegal or anti-social behavior, critical appraisals of family members, income, or privileged relationships, such as doctors or lawyers, parents may opt their children out of its administration. This requirement also applies to the collection, disclosure, or use of student information for marketing purposes.
- 2. Secondary schools are to provide, upon request from military recruiters or an institution of higher education, access to secondary school students' names, addresses, and telephone numbers. Parents may request in writing that their child's name not be on the list.
